FROM OUR PASTOR MSGR. STEPHEN DOKTORCZYK

Brother and sisters in Christ,

There is cause for rejoicing here, to quote Saint Paul. On Saturday, May 6, 122 students received Jesus for the first time in Holy Communion. This was a day of great joy as the children have been preparing for this moment for the past two academic years. They had opportunities to make their first confessions as well these past months. How grateful the parish is to all of those who are involved in our faith formation program. Though what they do is secondary to the role of parents in the faith life of their children, these teachers, aids and staff do their best to ensure that each child is prepared, but in their heads and hearts, to receive the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

But wait, there's more! This past Tuesday, 78 high schoolers received the sacrament of Confirmation, making the decision to live for Christ daily and to have their baptism strengthened by being confirmed. In the Sacrament of Confirmation, the baptized person is "sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit" and is strengthened for service to the Body of Christ.

We rejoice indeed, and rightfully so. However, if we are honest we will admit that not everyone who receives these sacra-

ments is practicing the faith on a regular basis. Praying that all of the Christian faithful will be on fire for Christ is a worthy intention to present to the Lord, including for our newly confirmed and those who received Holy Communion for the first time (199 in all).

We pray as well for all mothers, to whom we all should be most grateful. I am edified by the example of mothers in this parish, some of whom are juggling a lot to ensure the family gets to Mass and the children are properly educated in the faith. There are also mothers, not uncommonly "empty nesters," who struggle because their children (or some of them) have no interest in attending Mass or even ensuring sacramental preparation for their children. We pray too for these mothers, some of whom claim St. Monica as their patroness, and for those who no longer practice the faith. A special thank you to all mothers for your powerful witness, appreciated by your natural/biological family and by your church family.

Let us thank God for the many blessings he regularly bestows upon our parish and upon our families.
