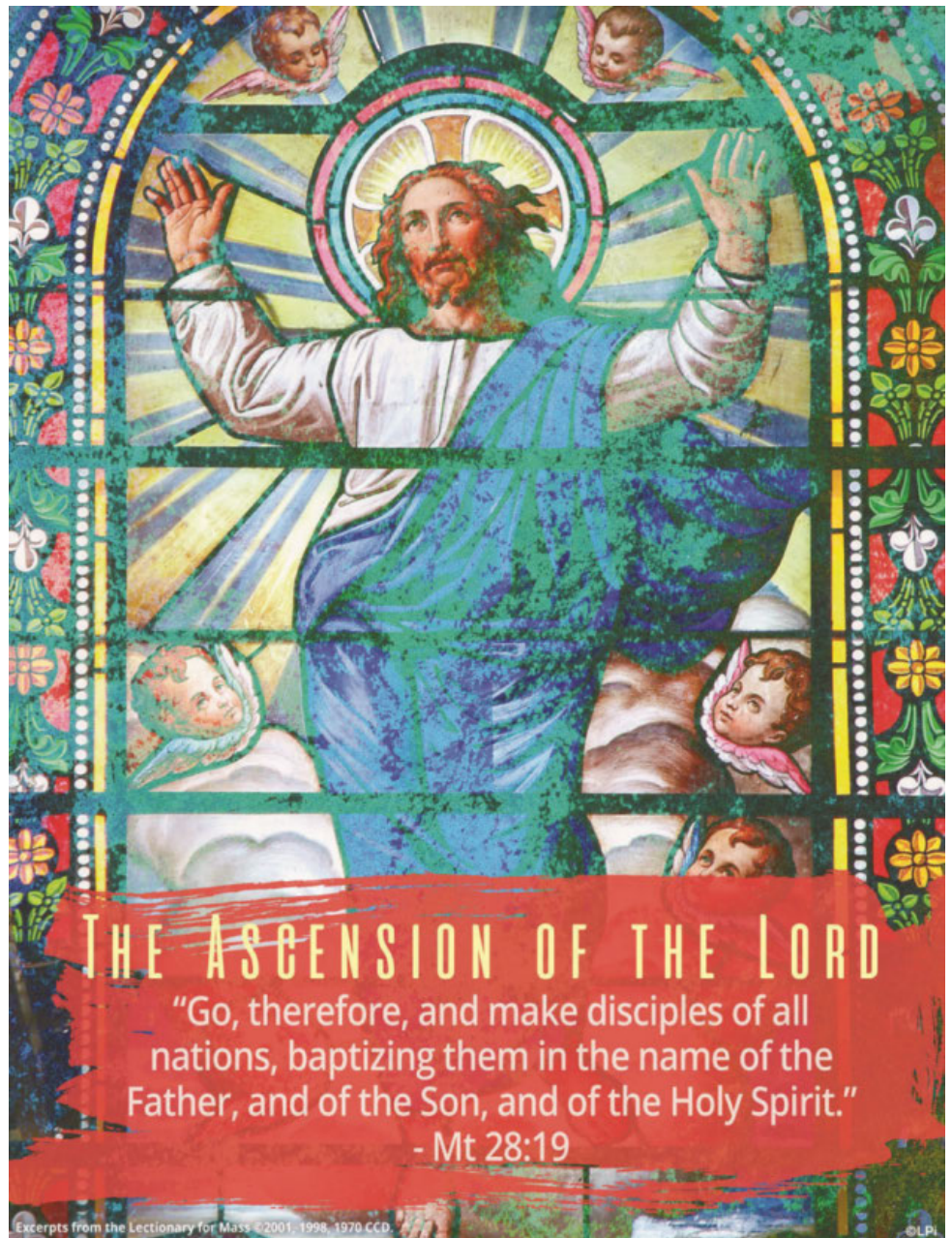

FROM OUR PAROCHIAL VICAR FATHER NICOLAUS THAI

The fifty days of the Easter season come to an end next Sunday on the feast of Pentecost, commemorating the fulfillment of Jesus' Gift of the Holy Spirit bestowed on the early Church. It seems that this also being the return to the liturgical season of Ordinary Time can give the impression that things return to the ordinary, mundane routine of living the faith, with not so many special feasts to celebrate, except the solemnities of the Most Holy Trinity and the Body and Blood of Christ. However, the special outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles, Mary, and the early followers of Jesus, on more than just those who had been present in the Upper Room on the first Easter Sunday, showed that additional disciples were invited and given the gifts and ability to live, share, and bear witness to the Good News of Jesus Christ. They were actually commissioned! Another way of saying this would be that they were empowered, thrust into the world, to proclaim what they had just witnessed and understood from our Lord's life events, His Passion, and His Ascension. Thus, all fully initiated Catholics, having received the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation, especially those who have recently been confirmed participate in and continue this commission. Hence, after celebrations of mysteries of our Lord, Ordinary Time provides opportunities to continue living the faith afresh, from understanding the history of salvation recounted in the Mass readings with new appreciation and insights, to more fervently participating in the sacramental life, and to more courageously living out the relationship with the Lord through boldly proclaiming the Good News both in words and deeds!

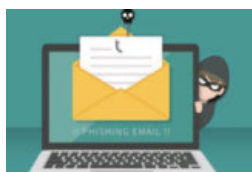
Honoring First Responders!

BEWARE OF PHISHING EMAILS



Phishing is a cyber-attack that uses disguised emails as a weapon. Msgr. Stephen Doktorczyk's name is often used on these phishing emails. It is not the practice at St. Martin de Porres for the pastor, parochial vicar or any office staff to solicit donations of gift cards or to seek out help for personal needs.

E-mail messages of these types, often written with poor grammar and filled with typos, should be ignored. The email may even address you by name and ask you to respond. If you receive an email with Msgr. Stephen's name, always check the actual email address before responding. Msgr. Stephen's St. Martin de Porres email address is **stephend@smdpyl.org**. Any other email address that uses any variation of his name is a phishing email. Please **do not** open or respond to these messages, and if in doubt, contact the Parish Office.

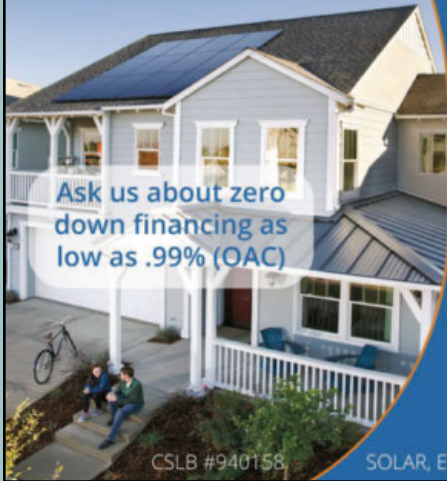

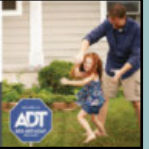

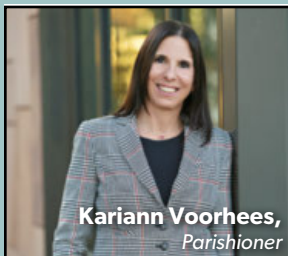
