

# FROM OUR PAROCHIAL VICAR FATHER NICOLAUS THAI

Per the weekly devotional practice, the Litany of the Sacred Heart was recited last Friday after the weekday's 6:30 pm Mass, more especially on the solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus itself. A parishioner later expressed that the brief quiet period between the end of the series of invocations and the concluding prayer was much enjoyed because this silent pause brought to mind the whole purpose of praying the litany. An absence of noise, accompanied by lack of external activities, brought about clarity of mind and fostered correct realization, resulting in better praying experience, and not just going through the words.

Contrary to the typical image of summer being an occasion of rest, relaxation, and rejuvenation, it could be usually and easily occupied with travels, plans, or constant activities. In addition, life in the modern age is filled with noise. As a result, this annual short break does not really provide or foster opportunities for potential deep self-understanding or wholistic understanding of one's life, leading to feeling exhausted, restless, lost, and purposeless. As God speaks to Elijah in a "light silent sound" (1 Kings 19:12, NAB), time reserved for self, silence, and rest could lead to an encounter with God, realizing and hearing His guiding, encouraging voice for the next steps in the journey of faith which can be challenging from time to time due to lack of having answers to questions or of strength to face and overcome problems.

A constant temptation would be to burden one's life with nonstop activities, hoping that this would lead to an increase in quality of living, while the reality is that a firm grasp and a wholistic understanding of life are absent. As professed Catholics, may we always remember God is the foundation our life and living relationship with the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit is crucial to being truly alive, and not just living through life. This is the quality of life.

Which areas in our lives can we unburden ourselves from to gain more quiet time and rest in order to hear God speak to us?
