



Our Lady of Mount Carmel *Feast of the Brown Scapular*

Tradition says that our Lady herself gave the Scapular to St. Simon Stock, Prior General of the Carmelite Order on July 16, 1251. She appeared holding the Child Jesus in one arm and the brown scapular in the other hand telling him, "Receive this habit, this shall be a sign of salvation. Whosoever dies clothed in this, shall not suffer eternal fire."

The second promise Mary made is known as the Sabbatine Privilege--Saturday, because our Lady promised scapular wearers who perform certain additional acts in her honor prompt delivery from purgatory, especially on the Saturday after their death.

Our Lady of Mt Carmel, Pray for us!



Saint Teresa of Avila *Reformer of the Carmelite Order*

St. Teresa of Avila, also called Teresa of Jesus became a Carmelite nun at the age of 20. She was the originator of the Carmelite Reform which restored and emphasized the austerity and contemplative character of primitive Carmelite life.

In 1970, Pope Paul VI, gave her the honor of being the first woman given the title, Doctor

of the Church, for her work and influence in theology.

Transverberation of St Teresa of Avila

Transverberation is a mystical grace wherein the Saint's heart was pierced with a "dart of love" by an angel. St. Teresa's transverberation was a unique vision because she saw the angel physically and bodily present. He had a golden arrow in his hand and used it to pierce the heart of St. Teresa. The bodily and spiritual pain she experienced was an ecstasy and was beautiful! It was an experience of the divine love of God!

SUNDAY MASS ROSARY MINISTRY

Before each Sunday Mass (and Saturday Vigil), the parish prays the rosary to ask our Blessed Mother's intercession and to prepare ourselves for Mass. Two prayer leaders are needed for each Mass. We have three openings at this time:

- Saturday 5:30 vigil Mass third week of each odd numbered month (i.e. Jan, Mar, May, Jul, Sep and Nov)
- Saturday 5:30 vigil Mass 5th week of the month
- **Sunday 10:30 Mass** 4th Sunday of odd months or the 5th Sunday of months with 5 Sundays.


Is the Lord calling you to be closer to His Church?
