FROM OUR DEACON NICK SHERG

When I was a little boy, my family had a boat that we took out in the ocean quite often. Whether it was making passages to Catalina or just going out for a day of fishing, I was always struck by the power and awesomeness of the sea. I remain so to this day. Sometimes the sea can hit us in the front, the back, the left and the right. There is no escaping it when we are in the middle of it. That is chaos. That is one of the messages of today's Gospel reading.

No matter what chaos there is in the world and in our lives, Jesus walks on it. He conquers the chaos and helps us to conquer it too, even that chaos which we ourselves cause in our own lives. Many of us have made bad choices. Many of us suffer the results of our sins or the sins of others. It makes no difference whether we caused the chaos or whether we suffer from the chaos caused by others. Jesus, by walking on water, calls us to "step out of the boat" and allow Him to help us conquer this chaos.

Most of the time, I can feel his hand as he guides me across the chaotic sea. But there are times when, like Peter, I blink and lose sight of the presence of our Lord in my life and that's when I begin to sink. It is then when Jesus says, "Don't be afraid," and He is there to reach down and lift me out of the water. He gives me the strength to join Him in conquering my chaos.

Where is the chaos in your life? Whatever that chaos is, please remember that there is nothing, no chaos, that is too great for Jesus to conquer. He walked on the waters, and He calls us to walk with Him. Don't be afraid.

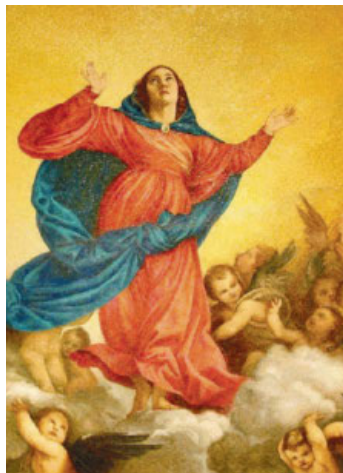

PARISH SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

The parish wishes to share with the faithful sacramental information from the past two fiscal years. The sacramental life of the parish is robust, though we pray for more baptisms, an increase in the number of adults who wish to convert to Catholicism and an increase in young people who look to complete their sacraments of initiation. Some of the 7/2021 to 6/2022 numbers were low due to continued Covid fears. The numbers are by no means the largest in the Diocese of Orange, as St. Martin de Porres would rank as an average sized parish. But we receive positive feedback from those who marry here or wish to bury a loved one. A bit unexplainable is the jump in requests for anointing of the sick, which the priests are ready to administer to those in need. A big thank you to volunteers who are involved in various sacrament related ministries.

We know that numbers alone are not a measure of the health of a parish. Still, we are pleased that no area experienced a decrease, with all but one area increasing, and some in a substantial way.

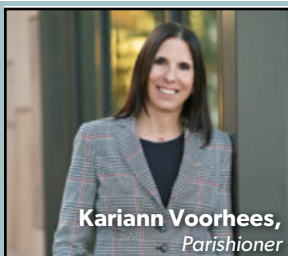

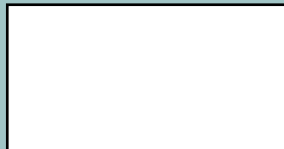
