

FROM OUR DEACON MARK MURPHY

As humans, with a tribal nature, we are good at drawing boundaries. Borders on a globe to divide one nation from another, lines to separate us by race, religion, political affiliation, socioeconomic status, gender, age, education, and a host of other "criteria" that conveniently create an us and a them.

Our readings today make clear that, in the end, the only separation that will matter will be those of us who believed and followed, and those of us to chose not to. Isaiah defines the first group as those who observe what is right, do what is just, and join themselves to the Lord. St. Paul's letter to the Romans obliterates the Israelite/Gentile divide and invites both groups equally into the believer/non-believer choice.

The Gospel starts with even Jesus holding the party line about Israelites and Canaanites. The key change in Jesus' approach to the woman comes when she says "for even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their masters." Where do you suppose these "scraps" came from? That's right, Jesus knew that there were Israelites for whom He had been sent who were not accepting Him or his teachings. They were literally letting His filet mignon message fall to the floor. It was only fitting that a woman of such profound faith should have access to that which others had denied.

Today, like astronauts viewing Earth from space, we see all of humanity as one. The only question that will separate us is this: Do I accept and live the Good News of Jesus?





FINANCIAL CORNER

Fiscal year 2023, which spanned 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2023, is now in the books. In last week's bulletin we reported positive gains in the number of sacraments administered by parish clergy compared to the previous fiscal year. We can report that Sunday collections for the same period were more than 99% of the those of previous fiscal year. Pastoral Services Appeal collections are significantly reduced compared to the previous year. More on PSA in a subsequent bulletin.

While ordinary collections are steady, costs have gone up, which is verified by the consumer price index in Southern California (Long Beach/Anaheim). A study of relevant CPI data shows that the average cost increase for fiscal year 2023 compared to 2022 was 6.08%. Such increases affect families as well as the parish. In these weeks and months ahead, we ask you to prayerfully consider increasing your gift to the parish, either by means of the Sunday offering, Pastoral Services Appeal or building fund. More specific ways of assisting will be suggested in the coming weeks. Thank you for your generosity, one thing (among many) that St. Martin de Porres parishioners are known for!

Question:

What is the meaning of the letters that professed religious have after their names?

Answer:

The Catholic Church includes hundreds of religious communities. The priests, religious brothers, religious sisters, and nuns of these communities (which are often referred to as "religious orders") are committed to particular spiritual traditions and often to a particular charism (such as teaching, healthcare, social work, or pastoral care).

To help identify a person as a member of a particular religious community, the custom developed of including postnominal letters that provide a sort of shorthand for the name of the community that the priest, brother, sister or nun is part of. So, for example OSB after a person's name would indicate that they are a member of the Order of St. Benedict (the Benedictines), just as SJ would indicate that a priest or brother is a member of the Society of Jesus (the Jesuits) or RSM would show that a woman is a Sister of Mercy.

Other common examples include:

DC = Daughters of Charity

FSC = The Brothers of the Christian Schools/Christian Brothers

OCist = The Order of Cistercians

OCD = Order of Discalced Carmelites

OFM = The Order of Friars Minor (the Franciscans)

OFM Cap = The Capuchin Franciscans

OP = The Order of Preachers (Dominicans)

OSF=Franciscan Sisters

SC = Sisters of Charity

SDS = Society of the Divine Savior (Salvatorian Priests and

Brothers and Salvatorian Sisters)

SSND = School Sisters of Notre Dame

SVD = Society of the Divine Word (Divine Word Missionaries)
