

### From Our Pastor Msgr. Stephen Doktorczyk

Dear friends in Christ,


For the past several months you have seen in the parish bulletin, on the outside monitor and on social media various references to the Eucharistic revival happening in the United States of America during this time, culminating next year. One reason for this initiative on the part of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) was to respond to what is seen as a grave lack of understanding among those identifying as Catholic of what the Eucharist truly is—Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ in even the smallest particle.


At St. Martin de Porres, we held a well-attended Eucharistic procession on Corpus Christi weekend in June. We continue to offer adoration around the clock, and Jesus is never left unattended. The scores of folks who sign up to adore Our Lord for one hour or more per week and many others who simply show up throughout the day without formally committing to one time or another is quite heartening for me to witness. These people don't question Jesus' real presence in the Host; rather, they relish in it and find it to be so important to them and their families that they regularly make sacrifices so that Jesus will never be alone in the church or chapel. And worshiping Jesus for many of us leads to other action—helping the poor and teaching religious education to various ages of the faithful are only two examples.

I believe we are on very good footing at the parish when it comes to belief in Christ's real presence and that practicing Catholics are aware of proper interior disposition one is to have before approaching the communion minister as well as proper outward, observable dispositions. We want to be on our best behavior for the Lord and avoid receiving him unworthily. Judging by the positive response to the parish's offerings of sacramental confession, it seems that a fair number at least are aware of our need for the Lord's mercy and forgiveness.

While we plan to offer more material (including via bulletin columns) to recognize this revival period, I think we would do well to focus on what we are already doing right and take advantage of the hard work done to get us to this point, including by those who did the research several years ago that convinced Fr. Sy to institute perpetual adoration at the parish. Prayer is a critical pillar of the life of a parish and of her individual members. Please consider participating in this worthy practice.


