

From Our Deacon Mark Murphy

Six years ago, on October 29, 2017, I had the honor of preaching my first homily on today's three readings. Our diaconate class was supposed to be ordained two weeks earlier and preach on the young man getting thrown out of the wedding feast for not having the right garment, "where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth." Tough way to start a preaching career. When our ordination was delayed two weeks due to a conflict in Bishop Vann's calendar, the new readings were today's: Love God and Love one another. **Whew**, I thought – Thank you Lord!

I remember wondering initially what exactly Jesus meant when He said, "the whole law and the prophets depend on these two commandments?" When Moses "lays down the **law**," do we hear God as stern or controlling? When the **prophets** urge "repentance," is that a sign of God's frustration with us? How do **these depend** on love?

Consider an example. Out of my ineffable affection for my grandchildren, I might lay down the **law** that they are to play in the yard and "shalt not" go into the street. And Grammy may play the role of **prophet**, reminding them of this law. But neither the law nor the prophet would be necessary in the absence of love. The law and the prophets exist to hold God's affection for us, like the **envelope** for His love letter.

In a world that fiercely glorifies individualism, we often find ourselves resistant to boundaries. Guidance with reminders can feel restrictive. However, as followers of Christ, we recognize that these boundaries are drawn for our sake. Every word, every directive from God emerges from His immeasurable love for us; a love so profound, it withholds nothing, as the crucifix reveals.

One of my great joys of being God's Deacon at St. Martin's for the last six years is encouraging you to *receive* that love *completely*, to *experience* it *deeply*, and to *reciprocate* it with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind, so that it may **overflow** to others, who desperately need it.

Parish Program Costs (including Staff) – Costs of operating the Parish programs including all Parish Faith Formation, Sacramental preparation, Youth Ministry, Music, Liturgy, and all program-related staff salaries & benefits.



The **Abortion Pill Reversal (APR)** was developed by Knights of Columbus Sir Knight, George Delgado, MD from San Diego. He partnered with Heartbeat International to inform women about a safe medical procedure that can reverse the effects of the first pill (medical abortions require 2 pills). Heartbeat International established a 24/7 hotline and a network of over 2,000 medical clinics who have doctors who can administer the reversal medication. These women are then referred to Pregnancy Resource Centers for follow-up care and support.

At no time does California Attorney General Rob Bonta express concern for the pre-born, or for women seeking pregnancy care. He does not report on the women who have used the abortion pills alone for "at home abortions" and ended up hemorrhaging to death.

Prayer, fasting, and vigils in front of abortion centers across the world have proven very effective in changing hearts and minds of not only those seeking abortions, but also of those immersed in the Abortion Industry. 40 Days for Life campaigns (40daysforlife.com) across the globe are leading in this effort.

Heartbeat International, Pregnancy Resource Centers, the American Association of Pro-life OBGYNS (APPLOG), and the Abortion Pill Reversal Initiative, are all partners that provide life-saving support for both mothers and babies. Numerous parishioners from St. Martins' Parish are involved in the 40 Days Fall campaign. As a Parish, St. Martins has provided support for Pregnancy Resource Centers such as **Life Center of Santa Ana** and for shelters such as **Casa Teresa**. Parishioners are involved monthly, praying the Rosary in front of the Planned Parenthood in Orange. All these efforts are helping to change hearts and minds in our "pro-abortion state" and helping to save lives one baby at a time.
