

FROM OUR PAROCHIAL VICAR FATHER NICOLAUS THAI

That the solemnity of All Saints and the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed are celebrated annually on November 1st and 2nd, respectively, reminds Catholic that the second-to-last month of a calendar year is not just about preparations for and celebration of Thanksgiving and upcoming holiday plans and trips. As the weather becomes cooler (I am not sure how cold it can be in our county), and it gets darker sooner, November brings with it a somber feeling, not only signaling the end of another year, but also, spiritually, calling Catholics, in praying for the souls of the deceased, to once again resume pondering and reflecting on how they have been living their lives and to which spiritual direction they are heading.

After the initial greeting and exchange, "The Lord be with you," and "And with your spirit," the Mass continues with the Penitential Rite that begins with the priest inviting the congregation, "Brethren (brothers and sisters), let us acknowledge our sins, and so prepare ourselves to celebrate the sacred mysteries." After a moment of silence, either the "I confess to Almighty God ..." or the Lord, have mercy is recited. The Penitential Rite is to call to the minds of the Mass goers that they are now not only in God's presence but also, by this very fact, that they have failed short of living as God intends them to. Contrary to some opinions that this sets a negative start to the Holy Mass, through this part of the Mass, the Church, reminds Her children that they are always in need of conversion because of their sinfulness, and, hence, to ask for God's forgiveness in order to worthily participate in the spiritual realities that are to be unfolded before them. This Rite, then, situates the congregation in a healthy spiritual and mental state, alerting them to God's graces that bring about their privilege to attend Mass where they continue hearing how merciful God has dealt with men and women in all ages, leading to union with Him, even though many of them have not responded positively to His invitation.

May we frequently examine the spiritual direction of our lives and not just during the month of November, not just at the beginning of the Mass in order to respond better to God's continuing mercy and love.



A KNIGHT TO REMEMBER


