

# From Our Deacon Nick Sherg

Today, we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family. It is a time for believers to reflect on the importance of family life and the example set by the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. The feast encourages us to recognize the importance of the family unit in the broader context of society and the Church.

The Gospel reading recounts the presentation of Jesus in the temple, an event that took place 40 days after his birth. This passage is rich in meaning and symbolism, and it offers various points for reflection. One key aspect is the emphasis on the virtues exhibited by the Holy Family. Mary's obedience and acceptance of God's plan, Joseph's role as a protector and provider, and Jesus' obedience and growth in wisdom are all qualities that serve as a model for Christian families. This can lead to further reflection on the role of parents in nurturing the faith of their children and creating a home where God is at the center.

In my reflection, this provides encouragement and inspiration in my own family life. It gives me insight to be mindful of the importance of prioritizing faith, love, and mutual support within my immediate and extended family. I admit that with the recent addition of three "families-in-law," this may not always be easy. Like all families, the Holy Family faced challenges (for example the Flight into Egypt). In these challenges, and even in the face of many other types of difficulties, we need to trust in God and be open to the Holy Spirit.

The Feast of the Holy Family also underscores the sacred nature of family life. Families are viewed as a domestic church, a place where faith is nurtured, and values are transmitted from one generation to the next. It is an opportunity to recommit to fostering an environment where love, respect, and understanding flourish. I know that I am particularly grateful for this type of generational love.

As we move forward in the new year, my prayer is that we all can reflect on the virtues of the Holy Family and how they can be applied to our own family life.

May God bless you and your family. Happy New Year!


