FROM OUR PASTOR MSGR. STEPHEN DOKTORCZYK

Dear friends in Christ,

The first reading, responsorial psalm and Gospel reading this Sunday share the theme of vocation—that of being called. We notice that Samuel listened attentively to the Lord, who spoke to him always while the boy was asleep. Though Eli, to whom Samuel was entrusted by his mother, seemed less familiar with the voice of God, eventually he rightly instructed Samuel how to respond should the Lord appear to him again: “Speak Lord, for your servant is listening.” Likewise, the Psalmist writes of one eager to respond to the promptings of the Lord, “with ears open to obedience.” The Gospel tells how, according to St. John, the first disciples came to follow Jesus—they listened to the words of John the Baptist and saw for themselves, soon being convinced that they had found the Messiah. Peter and Andrew didn’t take long to drop everything and follow Jesus.

How does the Lord speak to us in our day and age? Indeed through prayer, spiritual reading and Bible study. He does so also through others, who might notice something in a person and encourage him/her in a certain vocational path. Perhaps an employer or boss may see something in an employee or colleague and offer observations to that person.

In the Church, we believe that the Holy Spirit works through the bishop and others in the hierarchy, not that the Holy Spirit is limited to speaking only through such authority. Priests are to listen “with ears open to obedience.” I think back to December 8, 2010, when Bishop Brown presented to me a request made by the then Prefect (head) of the then Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, Cardinal William J. Levada, who had asked the bishop to release me to work in that office (located in Rome), provided I would say yes to the invitation. Part of my discernment included having lunch with the Cardinal when he was in town for the Christmas break. After he explained to me what the work would consist of, I asked him, “if you were in my position, what would you do?” He responded: “my practice has always been that if you don’t have a strong and well-founded reason to say no to an invitation or appointment by Church authority, you should say yes.” So I said yes. This resulted in 5 ½ years of experience I could not have gained elsewhere, including the opportunity to work part-time at the local seminary and to pursue doctoral studies concurrently.

Sometimes one receives a “call within a call” at what might appear to be an inopportune time. There are situations when families on short notice must relocate due to a work transfer. We don’t know what God might have in store—it might be sacrifice he is calling one to, a stepping out of one’s comfort zone perhaps, leaving behind positive experiences and friendships for something else. There are numerous examples in the bible of figures responding positively (and sometimes negatively) to God’s invitation, then normally presented through a prophet.

May our reflecting on today’s readings assist us to be truly open to the Lord’s call, which could come to us in different ways, and to keep in mind that our response may result in individual and communal sacrifice in the short term; trusting in Him must take pride of place.

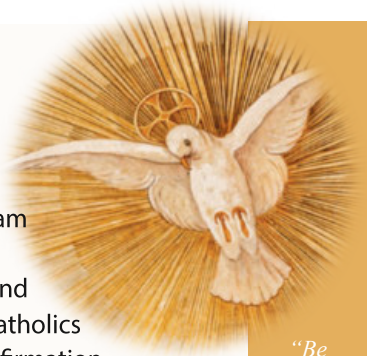

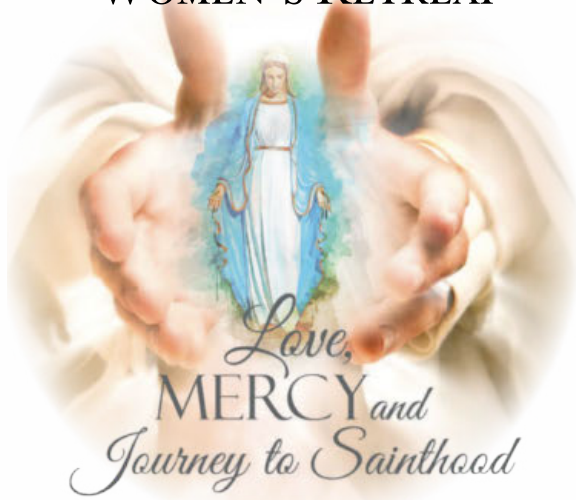

NEWS FROM RESPECT LIFE MINISTRY

January 20, 2024 will mark the 50th Anniversary of the National March for Life. In October 1973, a group of Pro-Life leaders met in Nellie Gray's home in Washington D.C. to decide how to commemorate the Supreme Court's January 20, 1973 Roe v. Wade and Doe v. Bolton decision that made abortion legal on demand throughout the country and invalidated state laws that had banned abortion. Their response was to establish the first March for Life in Washington D.C. in January 1974 to lobby legislators, endeavoring to find a legislative solution to the Court's ruling. When no legislative solution was presented, Nellie Gray decided to establish the Annual National "March for Life" in D.C. to take place on a weekday on or near January 20. The 2024 "March for Life" will take place on January 19; see www.marchforlife.org.

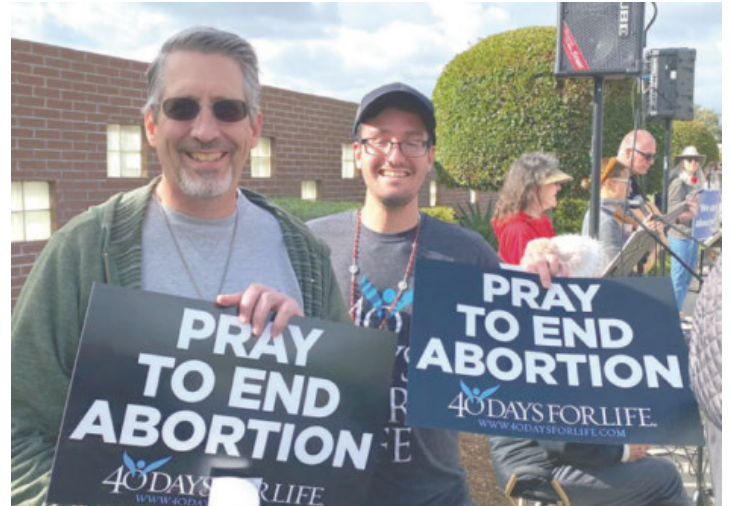
After the Court "overturned" Roe v. Wade and handed the decision back to the states in June of 2022, the March continued and expanded to include individual state marches.

The "March for Life" state organizations schedule their marches during the State legislative sessions. California State "March for Life" partners with the CA Family Council to sponsor this march. It will take place on Monday, April 22, 2024 at the Capital in Sacramento ([visit www.Ca.marchforlife.org](http://www.Ca.marchforlife.org)). The 20th Annual "Walk for Life West Coast" will take place on January 20, 2024 at 12:30 pm in San Francisco (www.walkforlifewc.com).

In 2015, the Archdiocese of Los Angeles established an annual event called "One Life L.A.," which was intended to "catalyze a movement of love and mercy in our city and our entire community" and to "...promote the beauty and dignity of human life from conception to natural death." It includes a formal "walk" in downtown L.A., speakers, entertainers, and food vendors and will take place on Statuary, January 20, 2024. The stated areas of focus are listed as: "pro-life, homelessness, human trafficking, foster care and adoption, the environment, the disabled, and Racism Immigration" ([see www.onelifela.org](http://www.onelifela.org)).

For those who are unable to attend these events, there will be an informal gathering to pray a "Rosary for Life" for an end to abortion, on Statuary, January 20 at 9:30 am in front of Planned Parenthood in Orange.

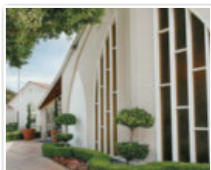

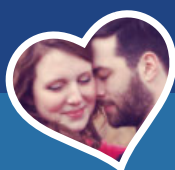
