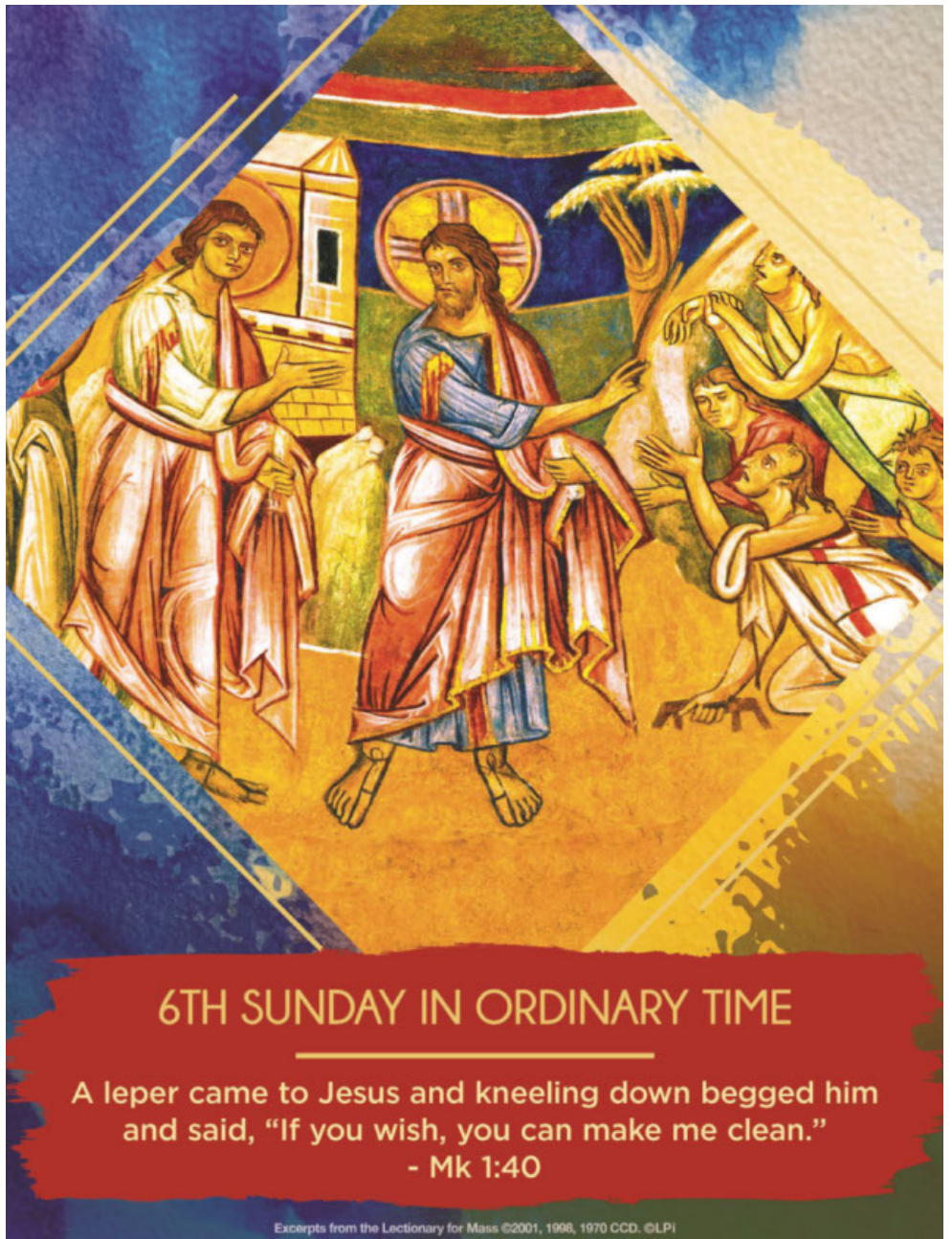

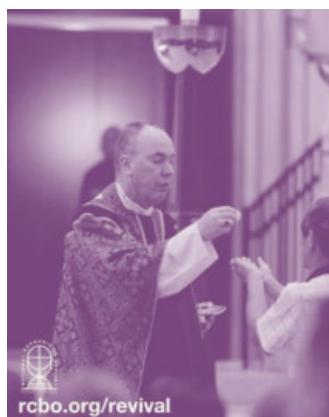

The Stations of the Cross are a 14-step Catholic devotion that commemorates Jesus Christ's last day on Earth as a man. The 14 devotions, or stations, focus on specific events of His last day, beginning with His condemnation. The stations are commonly used as a mini pilgrimage as the individual's attention moves from station to station. At each station, the individual recalls and meditates on a specific event from Christ's last day. Specific prayers are recited, then the individual moves to the next station until all 14 are complete.

ASH WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 14, 2024

This year, Ash Wednesday falls on February 14—Valentine's Day. As you know, Ash Wednesday is a day of both fasting and abstinence. As such, all Catholics without a medical impediment and from age 18 until age 59 are to fast (defined as limiting oneself to one full meal and two smaller meals that do not equal a full meal) and all Catholics without a medical impediment and 14 years and older are to abstain from meat. This will put a damper on the Valentine's Day celebration, to be sure, but we are to fully embrace these penitential practices. We have been informed that the bishop will not be entertaining requests for dispensations from the requirements of Ash Wednesday.

The parish will be offering seven different opportunities to receive ashes. See schedule below.

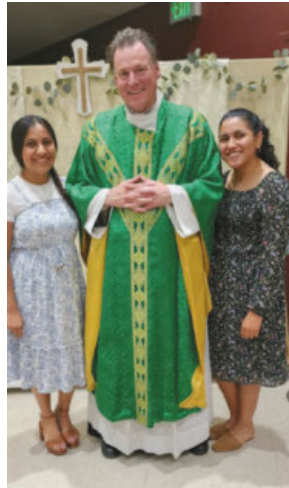

FROM OUR DEACON MARK MURPHY

Leprosy in the scripture is not only a very real physical illness, but also a metaphor for spiritual separateness. The Leper was isolated from society and (believed to be) unclean in the eyes of God. Aside from the horrific physical pain, it was an emotionally dark and lonely place to be.

What Jesus did in the Gospel is nothing short of shocking. *"Moved with pity, he stretched out his hand, touched him..."* He what? **Touched** him? Jesus crossed every border, physical and spiritual, in this single act. He exposed himself to contracting this terrible disease and (under Jewish Law), made himself spiritually unclean.

And then, Jesus warned him sternly, and instructed him to offer for his cleansing what Moses prescribed. In other words, after crossing all boundaries to meet this man where he was, Jesus invited him back into the community by encouraging the man to comply with the prescribed law. Much like what Jesus said to the woman caught in adultery – *"Neither do I condemn you. Go, and sin no more."*

Jesus demonstrates for us clearly **both** aspects of love. The crossing of all borders to include AND the calling back to what God has in mind for us. Healing AND reconciliation. Compassion AND accountability.

Parts of our society want to define love as the first part only... total acceptance, complete inclusiveness, unconditional approval. But we do not like the second part – the call to return fully to God. We are led to believe that any call to improvement is a sign that our love is not unconditional, and therefore we are haters. This "first-part only" love is simply not complete.

And some parts of our society, even within our Church, suggest that we only need the second part. To admonish them, judge them, tell them of their wicked ways. We want to stay on the other side of the street from these lepers, lest we become unclean like them. This "second-part only" love is simply not complete.

May the words and actions of Jesus today convey the deep truth that we must first cross the boundaries, meet them where they are, love them, and heal them. And then, we must invite them back home.

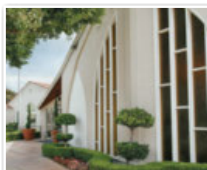
