Last weekend, we read you a letter from Bishop Joe Vasquez regarding the sad and horrible sexual abuse of many minors and seminarians in the Archdiocese of Pennsylvania that took place over a period of over 70 years. The Vatican rightly expressed "shame and pain" at this revelation, and I am convinced all of us share these same humiliating sentiments of shame, pain and hurt at this time. But we know the Catholic Church that Jesus founded on the rock of Peter is Holy and will always be. We, the members are not, but must always aspire to this holiness. Let us pray for healing for those who have been terribly hurt by these scandals, and for the Church to protect its vulnerable members. And for all of us, we pray for a spirit of forgiveness and the grace to live a holy life.
