**Gospel Reflection:** Carrying out the work of the seventy, the Church proclaims the coming of God's kingdom. She offers His blessings of peace and mercy to every household on earth, every town and place He intended to visit. Our Lord's tone is solemn today for, in the preaching of the Church, the kingdom of God is at hand. Those who do not receive His messengers will be doomed like Sodom. But those who believe will find peace and mercy, protection and nourishment in the bosom of the Church, the Mother Zion we celebrate in this week's First Reading, the "Israel of God" Paul blesses in this week's Epistle. The Church is a new family of faith in which we receive a name that will endure forever, a name written in heaven. In this week's Psalm, we sing of God's tremendous

deeds among men throughout salvation history. But of all the works of God, none has been greater than what He has wrought by the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ. Changing the sea into dry land was but an anticipation and preparation for our passing over, for what Paul calls the "new creation." And, as the Exodus generation was protected in a wilderness of serpents and scorpions, He has given His Church power now over the full force of the enemy. Nothing will harm us as we make our way through the wilderness of this world, awaiting the Master of the harvest.
