

Gospel Reflection: When St. Paul talked about the resurrection of the dead with the philosophers at Athens, many laughed and mocked him. Yet this week's First Reading tells us that it is foolish to think that the souls of the just are dead. Instead, By His Resurrection, Jesus frees the human race from the fear of death—from the terrible fear of the unknown, of our own disintegration—that holds us in a kind of slavery. Because He has walked the dark valley of death before us, because He has promised to walk alongside us, we can take courage and fear no evil, in the words of this week's Psalm. This is God's will for us, the reason Jesus came into the world, according to today's Gospel: That we will recognize Jesus as the Son of God and by believing in Him be raised to eternal life. If we believe in Him, we will follow Him, as the Psalmist says: He will refresh our souls in the waters of Baptism, anoint our heads with the oil of Confirmation, and set before us the table of the Eucharist.
