Classroom Supplies:

Please purchase for your child and label the items with his/her name.

1. One 13" by 13" storage cube –Please make sure they are 13x13. This ensures we will have enough storage room for them.
2. 5 composition books (no spiral bound)
3. One 1 inch binder
4. 7 two-pocket folders with holes to go in a binder. (laminated ones please)
5. Pencils (students should have 3 sharpened pencils each day)
6. 3 blue or black erasable pens
7. 2 red pens
8. 2 highlighters
9. 1 hand held pencil sharpener
10. 2 dry erase markers
11. An old sock or washcloth
12. 1 pack of post it notes
13. Earbuds
14. 1 pair of scissors
15. 2 glue sticks
16. Crayons or colored pencils
17. Plastic sleeve protectors for binder
18. Loose leaf paper with holes or theme tablet

For the Classroom:

1. 1 roll of paper towels
2. 1 box of baby wipes
3. 1 box of tissues
4. 1 ream of copy paper
5. 1 bottle of hand sanitizer/disinfectant wipes
