POPE FRANCIS AND OUR BISHOPS SEEK YOUR INPUT AND RESPONSE

- 1. In 2014, Pope Francis convened a Synod of Catholic Bishops to discuss, "The Pastoral Challenges of the Family in the Context of Evangelization."
- 2. Now the Vatican is inviting Catholic clergy and the Church's lay faithful to participate in a consultation survey as the Vatican prepares for the October 4 -25, 2015 continuing "Synod of Bishops" in Rome addressing the topic of, "The Vocation and Mission of the Family in the Church and Contemporary World."
- 3. First, all Catholic clergy and interested lay faithful who wish to participate need to go to the Vatican website (http://www.vatican.va.) then (click "Translate"), (click your needed language), (click "Roman Curia"), (click "Synod of Bishops"), (click "Lineamenta..." "and your needed language") to download and print-off a copy of the document entitled, "Lineamenta..."
- 4. You will first need to read, reflect upon this document and then answer the questions submitted to you on an official Vatican questionnaire which the parish will supply for you. The questions follow in sequence to the reflections found in this document.
- 5. This questionnaire is not on the Vatican website.
- 6. If you wish for a copy of the official Vatican questionnaire which accompanies the document you download, please sign up on the clip board located on our church Gathering Hall's "Welcome / Info Center" To save paper, the parish will then print off the number of questionnaires requested by our parishioners.
- 7. Vatican questionnaires will be printed and then placed on the "Welcome /Info Center" table in the church's Gathering Hall or at our School Office.
- 8. Responses must be legibly hand written to mail, or computer-typed to print-off and e-mail to our diocesan Chancellor who will collate them and forward them to Rome.
- 9. Email your computer-typed responses to Kabbey@cdlex.org or mail your legibly hand written responses to Karen Abbey -Chancellor, Catholic Diocese of Lexington, 1310 West Main Street, Lexington, KY 40508.
- 10. Responses must be submitted by March 12, 2015.

FAST AND ABSTINENCE

During Lent, Catholics in the United States abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and on all the Fridays of the season. They fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. They are encouraged to continue the fast on Holy

Saturday as well, in union with those preparing for baptism. On a fast day, people eat only one full meal; they may also eat two partial meals and should not snack between any of them.

The laws of fast and abstinence may vary from one country to another; however, they accomplish the same goals.

- 1.) They help us imitate the example of Jesus, who fasted 40 days to prepare for his ministry.
- 2.) They help us display our common repentance. More than declaring our personal desire for conversion of heart, they strengthen our community by expressing our corporate sorrow for social sin.
- 3.) They teach us a detachment from passions and turn our hearts more toward God and less toward food.
- 4.) They make us more disciplined and more charitable.

The purpose of fast and abstinence, then, is not to punish us but to make us more loving, more prayerful, more detached from whatever may keep us from God. Fasting becomes more spiritually effective when sustained by other practices such as prayer, charity and alms-giving. The prayers at Mass during Lent presume that the community is supporting its prayers with fasting and its fasting with prayer.

Everyone age 14 and older is bound by the law of abstinence. Younger children are to be educated in its significance. Other Catholics are expected to avoid meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Nonetheless, fasting is a praiseworthy penitential practice, even when it is no required.

Throughout the year, Catholics fast from food and drink one hour before sharing communion.
