NEEDED – PARISH BUS DRIVERS: Having now obtained our 14 passenger parish bus from a parishioner-donor for the purposes of our Good Shepherd parish needs, we now need adult women or men in Frankfort, who (1) have a valid Kentucky Driver's License (a CDL is not required for a church bus) and (2) a good driving record (3) to step forward to offer their time and talent to serve as parish bus drivers on a rotational basis when the need arises. The more rotational drivers we have, the scheduling demands will be lightened. For outreach/ evangelization purposes, we want our bus to be used to pick up Frankfort parishioners, KSU students and international students at Midway College who do not have transportation to attend a weekend Mass; to be used occasionally for our approved Youth Group and Senior Shepherd needs; and possibly to transport our Good Shepherd Parish students, who are actively attending Mass with their Catholic parent(s), our Youth activities and are enrolled at Lexington Catholic High School, to LCHS on weekday mornings. We will be looking at basic fees for some bus usages, and for any transportation to LCHS to help cover the maintenance/fuel/insurance needs of our bus. Questions? *Interested ? 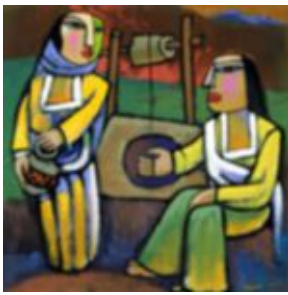

T E N E B R A E **"WE REMEMBER CALVARY"**



The Good Shepherd Chorus, the Little Flowers of Jesus, the children and high school students who participated at the Christmas Pageant 2014 are once again coordinating together to present this year's Lent Cantata, TENEBRAE, We Remember Calvary by Joey Raney.

The Tenebrae/Cantata will be presented on **HOLY THURSDAY, April 2nd, at 6:15 pm.** The Holy Thursday Mass follows at 7:00 pm. Derived from the Latin word for "shadows," Tenebrae refers to a worship service designed to recreate emotional and spiritual aspects of the passion story. "We Remember Calvary" is a Cantata that uses both traditional and contemporary hymns, worship songs, congregational singing, scripture reading, and narration to paint a vivid and moving picture of Christ's last days and his journey to the cross. The overall tone is one of reflection and worship.















This 35 minute work encourages optional congregational singing of very familiar tunes; to mention some songs are: The Old Rugged Cross, Here I am to Worship, My Faith Looks up to Thee. Seven candles are pre-lit at the beginning of the Tenebrae, located anywhere in the worship space, together. The candles are extinguished one at a time, as the Tenebrae cantata progresses, leaving the congregation in total darkness by the end.
