### DOING GOD'S WILL

**"Here I am, Lord, I come to do your will." Psalm 40**

Scanning the newspaper obituaries one morning, I came across a familiar name. Although I recognized the name, I knew little about the woman except her devotion to her family. The brief obituary described, in just a few sentences, a woman who led a life of remarkable service. While reading it, I learned that she and her husband adopted their six children and opened their hearts and home to 130 foster children over the years. That astounded me, and I found it difficult to imagine the extent of her selflessness and humility. I honestly could not comprehend such generosity and such a capacity to love.

Alongside the obituary was a lovely photo of this woman taken some 70 years earlier. The clarity in her eyes and the resolve in her face made me wonder if she already sensed God's will for her life at that tender age. It was only a guess on my part, but I took comfort in the assurance of her gaze, as if she had been telling us all, "Wherever God's will leads, you have nothing to fear."
