### St. Vincent DePaul Society's Quarterly Report July-September 2020

Thank you Good Shepherd parishioners! YOU helped 598 families with 1,297 adults and 865 children. YOU helped the poor with their home rent and motel stays, totaling \$14,781.91. YOU helped with city bus tickets and Greyhound bus tickets, costing \$384.23. YOU helped with their utilities to keep the lights, water, phones on, costing \$5,747.77. You assisted with medicine, costing \$16.99. Total disbursements were \$20,930.00. YOUR charitable gifts totaled \$13,141.98.

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
