What's MYSTAGOGY? From Aleteia: Following the celebration of the Easter Vigil and their entrance into the Catholic Church, the newly baptized enter into the catechetical period known as Mystagogy. The word comes from the Greek mystagogos, which has at its root the word mystes (one who is initiated into the mysteries). Mystagogy then is a time when those newborn in Christ are initiated into the various mysteries of the Catholic Church. From the CCC 1075: Liturgical catechesis aims to initiate people into the mystery of Christ (It is "mystagogy.") by proceeding from the visible to the invisible, from the sign to the thing signified, from the "sacraments" to the "mysteries."
