We Celebrate the Saints Our Lady of Lourdes February 11<sup>th</sup>

The Memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes recognizes the apparitions of the Blessed Virgin to St. Bernadette Soubirous, a young peasant girl who, although not known for great intellect, was able to articulate the Virgin as "the Immaculate Conception," thus giving credibility to her experience. Lourdes has become a place of pilgrimage and healing, but even more of faith. Church authorities have recognized over 60 miraculous cures, although there have probably been many more. To people of faith this is not surprising. It is a continuation of Jesus' healing miracles—now performed at the intercession of his mother. Some would say that the greater miracles are hidden. Many who visit Lourdes return home with renewed faith and a readiness to serve God in their needy brothers and sisters—Franciscanmedia.org. 



