



A Thought for the 26^h Sunday in Ordinary Time – Year C

Today's Liturgy of the Word opens with the prophet Amos, quoting God and crying out, "Woe to the complacent," who enjoy comfort and rich foods.

These words prompt some serious soul searching. The key is the last word,



"complacement." The real tragedy Amos sees around him is complacency. The rich man had learned to look the other way.

The ghost story told by Jesus which follows, no doubt, is meant to disturb our peace. He addressed it to the upright, the Pharisses. Folks perhaps equivalent to the pillars of the community, the parish, the clergy, the religious.

At the final judgement God will ask us about our stewardship, especially our care for the poor. (Mt. 25) What sacrifices can you make so that you can reach out to the poor more fully?

In our brief time on earth, how can we seize the opportunities to act charitably, to give generously, or to ease the suffering of another?
