- Invite them to faith activities even if it is just praying a rosary with you.
- Often ask God to bring them someone they will listen to, a friend, peer or colleagues.
- ♦ Never quit or give up.
- Pray with others for them.
- Offer your reception of the Eucharist for them.
- Offer your pains and suffering, even the ones that eventually take your life, for their conversion.


