Out With The Old & In With The New 2024

When you consider the things, you need and those you want to accomplish for the new year. does your faith life get a few spots on the radar? What would be some good things to pray about putting on your list of things to do?

Read Scripture at least 3 days a week. Pick a gospel or a book of the bible and stick with it. (Skip Revelation until you've read the rest.)

Daily rosary is a very productive way of growing closer to the Lord.

That favorite sin you have struggled with for years, come up with a game plan to kick it to the curb. Dive into finding out why the Church teaches something you have never quite understood.

When you get multiple days off in a row, use at least one of them to attend a daily Mass.

Get to confession at least once each season (Winter, Spring, Summer, and Autumn)

Volunteer to help or participate in something in the parish regularly

Read the bible to children/grandchildren in your life

Get a blessed item for your house (crucifix, icon, picture, framed bible quote, etc.)

Learn the names of those who sit near you in Church

Spend at least 10 -15 minutes before the tabernacle regularly

Perhaps come to Eucharistic adoration at least monthly

Start taking a look at the Mass readings prior to Mass

Stick around a few minutes after Mass to make a proper Thanksgiving for having received Him in the Eucharist.

Once a month invite someone to/back to Mass with vou

Have a Mass offered for deceased loved ones.
