This weekend we celebrate the magnificent solemnity of Corpus Christi!

(The Body and Blood of Our Lord, Jesus Christ!) Christ Himself is the greatest gift of God. He invites us to partake of Him when we are in a state of grace. The Gospel of John makes it clear:

“6: 47 Truly, truly, I say to you, the one who believes has eternal life. **48** I am the bread of life. **49** Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and they died. **50** This is the bread that comes down out of heaven, so that anyone may eat from it and not die. **51** I am the living bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats from this bread, he will live forever; and the bread which I will give for the life of the world also is My flesh. **52** Then the Jews *began* to argue with one another, saying, “How can this man give us His flesh to eat?”

53 So Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in yourselves. **54** The one who eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day. **55** For My flesh is true food, and My blood is true drink. **56** The one who eats My flesh and drinks My blood remains in Me, and I in him. **57** Just as the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, the one who eats Me, he also will live because of Me. **58** This is the bread that came down out of heaven, not as the fathers ate and died; the one who eats this bread will *live forever.*”

Why is it necessary to receive Him in a state of grace? When we receive Him outside a state of grace, we bring intense condemnation upon ourselves. If we have missed Holy Mass when we had a choice. If we are having physical relations outside of a sacramental marriage (including solitary activities. If we have broken any of the ten commandments or have failed to help those in need when we had the ability to help them. Etc. etc.

It is an honor and a privilege which none of us will ever be fully worthy of in this world to receive our Lord Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. Yet, we need to at least be free of the mortal sins. Fortunately, God gives us a means to address it with the sacrament of reconciliation. Even if we cannot receive Him due to the state of our soul, we still need to come to Holy Mass. We can lay eyes upon the risen Lord. We can be in His presence. We take in His Holy Word. He is to be WORSHIPED! Not for His sake, we cannot make Him greater. For our sake we proclaim the awe and splendor of Jesus Christ, especially in the Eucharist.
