THE FEAST OF THE CHAIR OF ST. PETER

On February 22nd each year, the Church celebrates the feast of the Chair of St. Peter. As early as the 4th Century, there is evidence of a Christian feast celebrating the Chair of Peter. The significance isn't the chair itself, but rather the authority it represents. The Latin word for chair, cathedra, is where we get the word cathedral. And when a pope speaks a pronouncement with his full authority as head of the Church, he is said to speak "ex cathedra" or, "from the chair." So, when we observe the Feast of the Chair of St. Peter, we're celebrating the office of the pope as the authoritative head of the Church. *(from usccb.org)*
