



SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

Questions and Answers about Lent. Why do we say that there are forty days of Lent? It might be more accurate to say that there is the "forty day fast within Lent." Historically, Lent has varied from a week to three weeks to the present configuration of 46 days. The forty day fast, however, has been more stable. The Sundays of Lent are certainly part of the Time of Lent, but they are not prescribed days of fast and abstinence. I understand that Catholics ages 18 to 59 should fast on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, but what exactly are the rules for these fasts? Fasting on these days means we can have only one full, meatless meal. Some food can be taken at the other regular meal times if necessary, but combined they should be less than a full meal. Liquids are allowed at any time, but no solid food should be consumed between meals. In all cases, common sense should prevail, and ill persons should not further jeopardize their health by fasting. KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS MASS & ROSARY FOR LIFE


