SAINT JOSEPH OF ARIMATHEA - AUGUST 31

In all four Gospels, Joseph was the brave Jew who asked Pilate for Jesus' crucified body and buried him. Mark calls him "a distinguished member" of the Sanhedrin, while Luke notes that he "had not consented" to the council's plan. In Matthew he is "a rich man," and John says he is a secret disciple of Jesus "for fear of the Jews." He shares his feast with Nicodemus, another Jew who went to Jesus secretly. From medieval times Joseph was associated with Holy Grail legends. *(from uscch.org)*

RCIA REGISTRATION

The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) program is for any adult who is:

- Un-baptized: Those who have never been baptized and seeking to be Baptized, Confirmed and receiving Holy Communion.
- Baptized in another tradition / religion: Those seeking to make a Profession of Faith to enter the Church and in doing so, receiving his/her Sacraments.
- Baptized Catholic, but with no further religious training: Those in need of First Holy Communion and Confirmation.

Registration has begun and will continue until Sunday, September 13, 2020. Late registrations will be accepted until September 20, 2020.

Classes will be held on Sundays beginning with the 9:30 a.m. Mass and continuing after Mass in St. Joseph's Hall until 11:45 a.m. Our first class will be on Sunday, September 13, 2020.

The Fall Session will be from September 13th until December 13th and the Winter Session will be from January 10th until March 30th. Candidates must complete both sessions to receive their sacraments.

Due to the circumstances concerning Covid-19; our class "in-person" sessions will be limited; however, they will be complimented by online sessions. Further instructions will be offered once class begins.
