What's the difference between normal conflict and domestic violence? Conflict is part of every intimate relationship. Domestic violence, however, has no place in a healthy relationship, whether the couple is dating, cohabiting, engaged, or married. Domestic violence is any kind of behavior that a person uses, or threatens to use, to control an intimate partner. The two key elements are threat and control. Both women and men can be victims of domestic abuse. The U.S. Catholic Bishops have made clear that violence "inside or outside the home, is never justified. Violence in any form-physical, sexual, psychological, or verbal is sinful; often it is a crime as well." 

SAINT MARIA SOLEDAD TORRES ACOSTA + October 11 +

As a child in Madrid, Spain, Manuela Torres Acosta reportedly was more intent on getting playmates to pray than to play. In 1851, she and six companions were invited by a Servite priest to provide home care to the sick of his parish. Taking the name Maria Soledad to honor Our Lady of Sorrows and overcoming her fear of nursing, she became a founder of the Handmaids of Mary Serving the Sick. As superior for 35 years, she oversaw the congregation's rapid expansion and battled government opposition; she was canonized in 1970. One of her novices said, "Mother Soledad is like an anvil; she is constantly taking a beating."
