



Greetings to one and all!

A lot is going on around the Cathedral, and all seems to be pointing in a very good direction. Last week, I had two very good meetings with two important Councils here in the parish.

The first Council I met with was the Finance Council. Canon Law requires that all parishes have a Finance Council because, in our case, as the Rector, it is my responsibility to be a good steward of the money you give for the operations of the Cathedral parish. It is not my money to do as I wish. It is your money that I must be responsible with and be a good steward of so that the mission of the Cathedral will continue. The Finance Council makes sure that I understand this and watches over all the financial happenings within the parish. The Finance Council presently in place is a very good and caring Council. I appreciate their counsel and guidance. In coming to understand more and more the financial situation presently at the Cathedral, they have been very good in their work, as has Donald Harris. I am getting to understand the money situation here. There are some questions in my mind; however, I am coming to understand things better and better as time goes by. In the coming year, we will see where the Good Lord brings us. But do be assured that I will do my best to be responsible with your money. I do take that very seriously.

The second Council I met with was the Parish Pastoral Council. Canon Law speaks of this council, and this is the title Canon Law gives for this council. In many settings, it is called the Parish Council; however, that can give the impression that it is a “Board of Directors” within the parish, which it is not. It helps the Pastor, or in our case, Rector, with his pastoral responsibilities to the parish he has been assigned. A Pastor, or in our case, Rector, has three responsibilities: to govern, to sanctify, and to teach. The Parish Pastoral Council enables these responsibilities to take place. The Council provides counsel to me so that I can fulfill these responsibilities. Our local law here in the Diocese of Corpus Christi requires that each parish have a Pastoral Council. This was our first meeting, and it was wonderful. So many ideas poured forth from everyone, and it was very clear to me that there is a desire to build the parish community. Between now and the end of the year will be a very busy time for most, if not all, of us, but once we turn the clock and 2024 begins, there are many things that we can engage in so that we can build up the parish community here in a good way. For this to happen, all we need is you, the community, to come together, work together, and form the parish community that God is calling us to become. Ideas such as small discussion groups, small classes on church documents, Bible studies, fellowship nights, etc. were brought up as were other things.

So, God is moving us as a parish community, and I look forward to serving you as we forge ahead. Again, let us enter the end of the year, a wonderful Thanksgiving time, Advent Season, and beginning of the Christmas Season, and then see where the new year takes us. Again, I thank these two councils for their help, their guidance, and their good counsel. I thank all of you for your presence in this parish community. May our prayer be that we now begin to move forward as God is calling us to move, so that we will be the Corpus Christi Cathedral parish community that God is calling us to be.
