

PARISH SACRAMENTS

BAPTISM

Baptism is new life in Christ, welcoming us into the Church. Parents should complete the registration packet 2-4 months before their baby's due date. Visit the website for details.

RECONCILIATION

Confession brings us into Christ's healing mercy and restores us in His grace. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered 30 minutes before all weekday and weekend Masses.

EUCHARIST

In the Eucharist, Christ is truly present-Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity-to nourish us spiritually. First Communion prep takes place at our parish First Saturday gatherings; families may register online. If you missed the deadline, please call the office.

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation strengthens us with the gifts of the Holy Spirit and completes initiation into the Church. Eighth graders prepare through Sunday formation, a March retreat, and celebrate the sacrament in April.

MATRIMONY

Marriage is a covenant of faithful love, reflecting Christ's love for the Church. Couples should complete preparation at least 6 months before the wedding. Contact the office for details.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

This sacrament offers Christ's healing and strength to the seriously ill, those preparing for surgery, or the dying. To request Anointing of the Sick or Last Rites, call the parish office at 337-896-9408.
