

Rosary Congress

The Rosary Congress begins October 1 in the Diocese of Victoria. As part of the deanery Rosary Congress, Our Lady of Lourdes will host devotion to Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary on Monday, October 2rd. Daily Mass is at 8:00 am with the Rosary to follow. There will be Eucharistic Adoration with the Rosary prayed on the hour every hour from 8:30 am until 6:00 pm. Bishop Cahill has announced the 2023 intentions for our diocese. They are: in reparation for the sins of bishops and priests; in reparation for sins against the Holy Eucharist, and for an increase and awareness of the real presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist; for the gift of peace, especially in Ukraine; and for an increase of vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life from our families. For your convenience, sign-up sheets are placed on tables at the narthex of the Church. Rosary leaders are asked to volunteer and you are encouraged to come pray together. We read in Matthew, chapter 18, verse 20: "For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them."
