#### **Holy Day of Obligation**

This Friday is the Solemnity of All Saints which is a Holy Day of Obligation. We honor the thousands of holy men and women who lived out their faith in such a way that we recognize them as now living eternally with God.

#### First Friday (November 1)

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament following the 8:00 am Mass (8:30 am - 12:30 pm)

#### **All Souls Day**

If you care to remember your loved ones during the month of November, All Souls Day Envelopes are placed at the entrance of the Church for your convenience. Envelopes will be placed on the Altar of Sacrifice and your loved ones will be remembered in the daily Mass intentions throughout the month. Your offerings may be placed in the collection basket or brought to the Parish Office.
