### *The Blessed Virgin Mary Jesus' Mother, Our Mother and Mother of the Church*

**Q. Why do we call Mary “the Mother of God”? How could God have a mother? (Continued from last week)** Objection to the title “Mother of God” arose in the fifth century due to confusion concerning the mystery of the incarnation. Nestorius, who was the Bishop of Constantinople (428-431), incited a major controversy. He stated that Mary gave birth to Jesus Christ, a regular human person *period*. To this

human person was united the person of the Word of God (the divine Jesus). He stated that this union of two persons - the human Christ and the divine Word - was “sublime and unique” but merely accidental. The divine person dwelt in the human person “as in a temple.” By this reasoning, he asserted that the human Jesus died on the cross, not the divine Jesus. As such, Mary is not “Mother of God”, but simply “Mother of Christ” - the human Jesus. Not only is this confusing, but it results in the splitting of Christ into two persons and the denial of the incarnation.

St. Cyril, Bishop of Alexandria (d. 440) argued against Nestorius, stating “It was not that an ordinary man was born first of the Holy Virgin, on whom afterwards the Word descended; what we say is that, being united with the flesh from the womb, [the Word] has undergone birth in the flesh, making the birth in the flesh His own...”

On June 22, 431, the Council of Ephesus, was convened to settle this argument. The Council declared, “If anyone does not confess that the Emmanuel is truly God and therefore that the holy Virgin is the Mother of God (*Theotokos*) (since she begot according to the flesh the Word of God made flesh), *anathema sit.*” (*Excommunicated*). Therefore, the Council officially recognized that Jesus is one person, with two natures—human and divine—united in a true union. Ephesus thus affirmed that our Blessed Mother can rightfully be called the Mother of God: **Mary is not Mother of God, the Father, or Mother of God, the Holy Spirit; rather, she is Mother of God, the Son-Jesus Christ.** The Council declared Nestorius a heretic, and the emperor ordered him deposed and exiled.

**Q. If the New Testament speaks of the brothers and sisters of Jesus, why do Catholics believe Mary to be ever-virgin?** The belief that Mary was always a virgin has been held since the earliest days of Christianity. Many of the early Church Fathers, including Athanasius, Jerome and Augustine, held this belief. In A.D. 411 St. Augustine said of Mary, “a Virgin conceiving, a Virgin bearing, a Virgin pregnant, a Virgin bringing forth, a Virgin perpetual.” Another source that supports belief in Mary’s perpetual virginity is the *Protoevangelium of James*. It was written around A.D. 120, when some of those who had known the apostles were still alive. It records that Mary was dedicated before her birth to serve the Lord in the temple. This required perpetual virginity so that she could completely devote herself to the service of the Lord.

**But, if Mary wasn’t supposed to get married, why was she engaged to Joseph?** Concerns about ceremonial cleanliness required that Mary have a male protector who would respect her vow of virginity. Joseph, according to the *Protevangelium*, was chosen by lot to take into keeping the “Virgin of the Lord.” His duty to guard Mary, was so serious, that when Mary conceived, Joseph had to answer to the temple authorities. So Mary’s betrothal to Joseph was not in conflict with her vow of virginity.

Then we have the biblical texts that show us that *Mary had chosen to be a virgin*. When the angel Gabriel declares to her that she will bear a son, Mary asks, “How shall this be, since I have no husband?” (Luke 1:34). At this point Mary was engaged to Joseph. Why would she be surprised at being told she would conceive? If she was planning on having children with Joseph (in the usual way) it wouldn’t make sense for her to ask how she would be able to have a child. This question only makes sense if Mary was already planning to remain a virgin.

**But, the Bible itself clearly states that Jesus had siblings?** “... his mother and brothers stood outside wanting to speak to him.” (Matt 12:46); “... Are not these his brothers James and Joseph and Simon and Judas?” (Matt 13:55); “So his brothers said to him,...” (John 7:3-4).

- \*RCIA is for Baptized Catholics who have received no other faith formation and have not received the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist
- \*RCIA is for children age 7-17 who have not been baptized. Parents should register for their child.

## Sacraments

**Baptism of Infants or children  
 under 7 years of age:**

You must be a registered parishioner of St. Patrick prior to scheduling a Baptism. To schedule a Baptism, please begin by calling the parish office. Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of each month immediately after the 11AM Mass. Please consider scheduling your child's Baptism before your child is born to ensure an opening in the month of your choice. In addition, a Baptismal preparation class is required for the parents. This is a one session class that is held on the 1st Sunday of each month after the 9AM Mass. Sign-up is required and you may take the class before your child is born.

**Sacrament of Marriage:**

At St. Patrick, couples planning to marry need to meet with the Pastor before a wedding date can be set. Please contact the parish office to setup an initial meeting **at least 6 months prior to any requested marriage date**. This initial meeting will give you an overview of the requirements for marriage and the preparation required. **At least one of the couple, or their parents, must be registered parishioners for at least 6 months and be active participating members of St. Patrick Church in order to be married at the church.** Both individuals must be at least 19 years of age.
