Dear Friends in Christ,

This week we will welcome The Most Rev. David J. Malloy, Bishop of Rockford, to celebrate the Eucharist and confer the Sacrament of Confirmation on the 20 teens & 3 adult candidates from our parish. Their names are listed on the front page of the bulletin, along with those joining us from Christ the King in Wonder Lake, St. Margaret Mary in Algonquin and St. Peter in Spring Grove. Please pray for them that this sacrament should fill them with the special gifts of the Holy Spirit: Counsel (Right Judgment), Courage (Fortitude), Fear of the Lord (Wonder and Awe), Knowledge, Piety (Reverence), Understanding and Wisdom. These gifts will help them to bear the fruits of the Holy Spirit: Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control, and to remain faithful members of God's family in the Church. Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of your Divine love. Send forth your spirit and they shall be created. And you will renew the face of the earth. Amen.

We also congratulate and pray for our children who received Jesus for the first time in Holy Communion this Saturday. Their names are also printed on the front cover.

This weekend brings us to the **Fourth Sunday of Easter**, also known as "Good Shepherd Sunday" and "World Day of Prayer for Vocations". The readings throughout the fifty days of the Easter season aid our appreciation of God's merciful love through the Paschal Mystery: the suffering, death and rising of Jesus. This Sunday we are invited to meet with the Good Shepherd and to nurture our relationship with Him by LISTENING to His voice.

On Good Shepherd Sunday, that is "World Day of Prayer for Vocations", we pray for vocations (call) to the priesthood and religious life. Strictly these are for those invited to ordained ministry, whom the Lord Jesus calls to shepherd in His name. In general, it could include all who act in place of shepherds. "Without priests there will be no Eucharist," that is, the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity through which Jesus, the Good Shepherd, feeds His flock sacramentally. In the Old Testament God shepherded His people beyond all wants, according to Psalm 23. This Old Testament image of the good shepherd finds fulfillment in Jesus who goes in search of us, shows compassion and sees us "as sheep without a shepherd" (Matt 9:36). Above all He lays down His life for His sheep (John 10:11). As a shepherd, Jesus acknowledges the sheep, "my sheep hear my voice, I know them, and they follow me" (John 10:27). Thus, He knows us by name and treats each one of us as though we were the only one who ever existed. That is to say, He gives them eternal life, and no one can take it away from the sheep.

Vocation strikes at the core of eternal life. The word vocation is derived from Latin VOCARE, where we derive words like; vocal; voice; volume etc. It simply means to call. In the Church there are two sacraments of vocation, through which God calls us to eternal life, namely, Matrimony (Christian Marriage - in the Church) and Holy Orders (religious and single lives). The Fourth Sunday of Easter however concentrates on vocations to the Priesthood (Deaconate) and Religious Life. Do you think God is calling you to the priesthood or religious life? The priesthood makes the Eucharist alive and is also at the service of other sacraments. It reveals Jesus the Good Shepherd who leads His flock to eternal pastures.

Together let us pray that God should touch the hearts of our children allowing them to consider giving themselves to the Lord in the Priesthood and Religious Life. Let us also pray for marriages so that couples may see their matrimony as an expression of Christ's love for His spouse, the Church, a response to the Good Shepherd's (God) call for them to come to eternal pastures.

This weekend also offers us the opportunity to make our pledge to "Do You Love Me" the 2022 Annual Diocesan Appeal in gratitude for all that Jesus has done for us. I am very grateful in anticipation for your generosity. Members of our Stewardship Ministry will be addressing us at all Masses. I pray that each of us individually and as a parish continue to bring the love of Jesus to those in need and teach the faith to young and old alike through your generous gifts to this year's appeal.

We also pray for all mothers this Mother's Day Weekend. May the Lord bless and reward them for showing us the path to God's love.

Sacraments

Baptism: To schedule a Baptism, please begin by calling the parish office. Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of each month immediately after the 11AM Mass. Consider scheduling your child's Baptism before your child is born to ensure an opening in the month of your choice. A Baptism preparation class, held on the 3rd Sunday of the month at 10:00AM, is required for the parents. You may take the class before your child is born. *You must be a registered parishioner of St. Patrick prior to scheduling a Baptism.*

Matrimony: Couples planning to marry need to meet with the Liturgy Director to begin the process before a wedding date can be finalized. Please contact the parish office to setup an initial meeting **at least 6 months prior to any requested marriage date.** This initial meeting will give you an overview of the requirements for marriage and the preparation required. **At least one of the couple, or their parents, must be registered parishioners for at least 6 months and be active participating members of St. Patrick Church in order to be married at the church.** Both individuals must be at least 19 years of age.

St. Patrick Catholic Church Parish Registration - Do You Need to Register?

ARE YOU: (1) New to the parish; (2) Moving back; (3) Just Married; (4) Attending mass but never officially registered? (5) Even if you grew up in St. Patrick, you (as an adult—18+) need to register independent from your parents.

Please do not take your church registration for granted. Attending Mass is not enough; there must be an official record of your membership in the Parish. **Parish registration is essential for many reasons.** It becomes important when you or your family members are receiving the Sacraments - First Communion, Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage. Registration is also required for those wishing to become a Baptism or Confirmation sponsor. In addition, becoming a member of a parish gives one the identity of belonging to a family—the parish family of St. Patrick Catholic Church.

If you are not officially registered with the parish, please do so as soon as possible. All you have to do is contact the parish office at 815-385-0025 or stop in during office hours and request a registration packet. Registration packets are also available on the parish website at www.stpatrickmchenry.org—just click on Registration at the top of the home page.

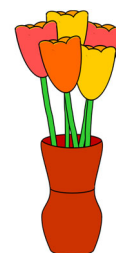

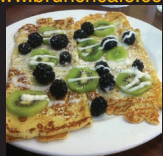

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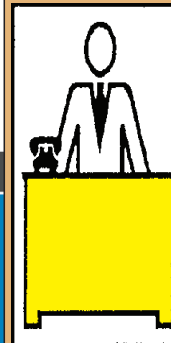
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
