





## St. Patrick Mission Statement

A welcoming parish called in FAITH to know, LOVE and serve God and neighbor in the HOPE of heaven.



Dear Friends in Christ,

I write to you today from the Holy Land. I arrived on Tuesday with the rest of the pilgrims on the Relevant Radio Pilgrimage with Drew Mariani. I am praying for you and please pray for me. I will see you next weekend.

The old saying, "No man is an island," is indicative of our need for relationships, a vital component of our existence. From this backdrop we can appreciate the reason that Jesus, in Luke's Gospel this weekend, calls us to build positive relationships with God and with each other.

Communication is essential to nurture and sustain our human relationships. Letters, phone calls, texts, notes, and social media among other means of communication help with this. To cultivate a relationship with God we also need communication with Him.

This is made possible through **PRAAYER**. Jesus emphasizes on persistent prayer when he talked about "the need to pray always without becoming weary... (Lk 18:1-8)" Do you want to improve your relationships with family, friends, and others? Begin by improving your relationship with God through prayer. When our most important relationship, the one with God, improves, so will our relationship with each other.

The Gospel story of a Widow and a Judge confirms and is indicative of our need for persistent prayer. She was persistent and the reluctant Judge granted her request. We tend to persist and persevere in what is important to us; exercise routines, athletic training, keeping up with our favorite sports, etc. So must it be with prayer, that is, if a relationship with God is important to us. Prayer may not always change things and the circumstances that we are facing. Sometimes it will change us, making it possible for us to handle things and situations that would not change.

When I was younger, I used to think that prayer is "talking to God." Over the years I have also come to know that the better part of it is when God talks to us, as such prayer becomes a communication with God who is the principal initiator of that relationship. Hence talking to Him, as good as that might sound, is only secondary to listening to Him. Fittingly the **greatest form of prayer is the Eucharist**, where the Father talks to us through His Word (Son). Then, He draws us to a relationship in the Holy Spirit through the sacrament. We compliment this relationship through our personal prayer, responding to the prayer of the Mass, singing, and our offerings, our Thanksgiving (Eucharistia) to God. During communion our relationship becomes a holy exchange where He gives us His Body as we give Him ours in return. Let me share with you a good old prayer you may want to use after Communion as you improve your relationship with Him. As you do this, keep in mind that, "No man is an Island," we need relationships with each other but above all with God through prayer.


#### **Connections to College Kids:**

### St. Joseph Icon At St. Patrick - October 22-28, 2022

### Prayer Service

### Wednesday October 26 at 6:00PM

Icon will be in the sanctuary throughout the week and will be available for private veneration whenever the church is open.

Every few years, the Knights of Columbus select an icon of a saint whose patronage is inspiring to all Catholics to share and honor. Flowing from the year of St. Joseph, comes their new Pilgrim Icon Program in honor of St. Joseph. The beautiful icon is housed at St. Joseph's Oratory in Montreal, Canada's preeminent Shrine to St. Joseph, founded by St. Andrew Bessette. In the Image, St. Joseph stands with his eyes cast humbly down, but with a determined strength in his face. In his covered arm he bears the Child Jesus, whose own hand is raised, blessing the world. In his right arm, St. Joseph holds a flowering staff, a sign that he was chosen by God. The white lilies of the staff signify his purity and chastity. Taken together, the icon provides a window into the life and mission of this courageous father, a man who was one of us and yet called to a mission of incomparable significance. Our world desperately needs men and women of courage. But in a particular way, it needs courageous fathers - men willing to stand up and to carry out their own mission of protecting, defending and raising future generations. It needs men willing to risk it all, in order to offer the world Jesus. In short, our world needs men in the model of St. Joseph.

**Ukrainian Catholics, belong to the Universal Catholic Church.** There are twenty-three distinct Churches which together form the Catholic Church: the Western or "Latin" Church, which nearly all Americans are familiar with, and the Eastern Churches, of which there are a total of twenty two. As Vicar of the Universal Church, the Pope is shepherd of the rites of the West and the East. The eastern rites which have a separate code of canon law are completely equal in dignity with the rites of the West. They follow the Eastern Orthodox rituals and rite, while embracing the authority and unity of being part of the Holy Catholic Church. The current head of the Universal Catholic Church, and hence the Ukrainian Catholic Church, is Pope Francis.

Differences between Ukrainian Catholicism and Roman Catholicism range from minor to significant. Ukrainian Catholics cross themselves from right to left, not left to right; Holy Communion is always distributed directly into the mouths of communicants by a priest using a spoon; and married Ukrainian Catholic men can be ordained as priests or deacons. However, unmarried clergy may not marry and widowed clergy may not remarry. Ukrainian Catholics celebrate their faith with the Divine Liturgies of St. John Chrysostom and St. Basil the Great.






## Communion for the Homebound

## All Souls Day - Memorial Candle Lighting Mass Wednesday, November 2, 2022 at 7:00PM

As in the past, St. Patrick will again remember all our parishioners who have passed to eternal life in the past 12 months (November 1, 2021-October 31, 2022) along with family members of our parishioners who have died. **The Memorial Candle Lighting will take place at the 7:00PM Mass on All Souls Day, Wednesday, November 2, 2022.**

Family members of all St. Patrick parishioners who have died in this time period have been sent a special invitation to attend this Mass and light a Memorial Candle during the Mass. You do NOT need to return the below form if you plan to attend.

Any parishioner who has lost a non-St. Patrick parishioner family member or friend in the past is also invited to participate in the candle lighting. A Tee Candle will be available to be lit for each name submitted but you may also elect to purchase a Memorial Votive candle (that will have your loved ones name on it) that you can take home for a donation of \$5.00. You may order more than one candle per person, but only one candle for each departed family member will be lit during the Mass.

As in the past, two easels will be setup in front of the Blessed Mother's statue, where you may place pictures of your loved ones who have passed away. **You may place the pictures (no larger than 5X7) on the easels beginning Saturday, October 29th.** We will leave the display up until the end of November and pictures should be taken home by Friday, November 25th. Please put your name and address on the back of the picture.







## Sacraments

**Baptism:** To schedule a Baptism, please begin by calling the parish office. Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of each month immediately after the 11AM Mass. Consider scheduling your child's Baptism before your child is born to ensure an opening in the month of your choice. A Baptism preparation class, held on the 3rd Sunday of the month at 10:00AM, is required for the parents. You may take the class before your child is born. *You must be a registered parishioner of St. Patrick prior to scheduling a Baptism.*

**Matrimony:** Couples planning to marry need to meet with the Liturgy Director to begin the process before a wedding date can be finalized. Please contact the parish office to setup an initial meeting at least 6 months prior to any requested marriage date. This initial meeting will give you an overview of the requirements for marriage and the preparation required. **At least one of the couple, or their parents, must be registered parishioners for at least 6 months and be active participating members of St. Patrick Church in order to be married at the church.** Both individuals must be at least 19 years of age.




