

Programs for 2023-2024 School Year

Option 1: Sunday Faith Formation

This option is traditional classroom model.

When: Classes will be held almost every Sunday throughout the school year from 10-11am.

Where: We will utilize the Montini Primary building for classes.

Who: Kindergarten through eighth grade will be taught by volunteer catechists.

What: We will teach from Loyola Press "Christ Our Life" series and the "Signs of Grace" and "Chosen" Sacramental preparation programs.

Parents will be asked to:

- Attend Mass with their child(ren).
- Bring their child(ren) to class weekly.
- Ask their child(ren) about what they are learning in their classes and assist with learning prayers.
- Support their child(ren) in living their faith in their home and community.
- For Sacramental-aged children, attend a monthly Sacramental preparation class with their child(ren) and complete requests of the Sacramental programs.
- In addition to Sunday class, families are welcomed to take part in the family gatherings associated with Family Faith Formation, however, it will not replace participation in the Sunday program.
- During six meetings of this year, the families will be asked to remain after 9am Mass for a message from Father. Children will then go to class and parents will be welcomed to fellowship time.
