Note to Parishioners: A few weeks ago, the Joint Good Shepherd Parish Finance and Pastoral Council advised parishioners that steps have been taken to protect parish funds from future loss as we proceed through the restructuring of the Archdiocese, including Good Shepherd Parish.

Effective immediately, all funds raised from fundraisers such as Grand in Your Hand, Cemetery Plot Fees (where applicable), In Memoriam donations or any donation received for the benefit of Good Shepherd Parish Cemetery committees will be placed "In Trust" with the Knights of Columbus Council Local 13320. Tax receipts <u>cannot be provided</u> for Grand in Your Hand tickets by either the Knights of Columbus or Good Shepherd Parish as that is not permitted under our Charitable Status regulations.

Please contact the Parish Office for instructions on how to properly donate funds to ensure you get a Tax Receipt and to ensure it is properly recorded for such things as cemetery upgrades, etc.

Please make sure you spread the word on this arrangement as hopefully, this will provide the future donors to GSP or purchasers of Grand in Your Hand tickets with sufficient comfort that these funds are fully protected.
