### THE GOSPEL FOR TODAY: Luke 11:1-13

He was praying in a certain place, and after he had finished, one of his disciples said to him, 'Lord, teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples.' He said to them, 'When you pray, say: Father, hallowed be your name.

Your kingdom come.

Give us each day our daily bread.

And forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive everyone indebted to us.

And do not bring us to the time of trial.'

'So, I say to you, Ask, and it will be given to you;

search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened for you.

For everyone who asks receives, and everyone who searches finds,

and for everyone who knocks, the door will be opened.

Is there anyone among you who, if your child asks for a fish,

will give a snake instead of a fish?

Or if the child asks for an egg, will give a scorpion?

If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children,

how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!'

### REFLECTING ON THE GOSPEL

One of the prayers that unites all Christians is "The Lord's Prayer," or the "Our Father." It has a special place in our hearts because Jesus taught it to His disciples, and it has been handed down in Scripture, in the Liturgy and through the lips of countless generations of parents and grandparents. The prayer contains seven petitions that focus our minds and hearts on what's important in life by summarizing all that we must do to be "good and faithful servants," namely: revere God, accept God's will, follow God's Word, love each other through forgiveness, and resist evil.

# JULY 26 PARENTS OF MARY GRANDPARENTS OF JESUS

The New Testament contains no specific information about the lives of the Virgin Mary's parents, but other documents outside of the Biblical canon do provide some details.

The "Protoevangelium of James," which was probably put into its final written form in the early second century, describes Mary's father Joachim as a wealthy member of one of the Twelve Tribes of Israel.

St. Joachim and St. Anne have been a part of the Church's liturgical calendar for many centuries. They are revered in many First Nations communities as wise elders, knowledge-keepers and storytellers, the grandparents of Jesus.



### World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly

Pope Francis instituted the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly on January 21, 2021 to highlight the importance of providing adequate pastoral and spiritual attention to the elderly and to call upon communities to manifest the closeness of the Church to them. It is to be celebrated annually on the fourth Sunday of July, close to the memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus.



The theme for the 2025 celebration selected by the pope is "Blessed are those who have not lost hope" (cf. Sir 14:2).
