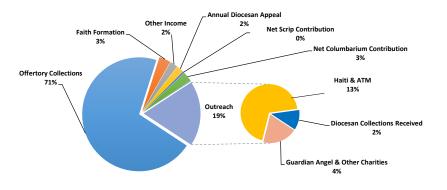

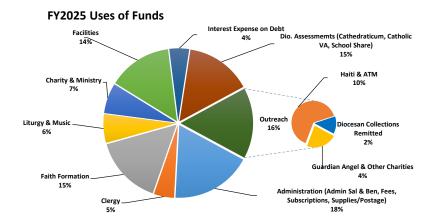

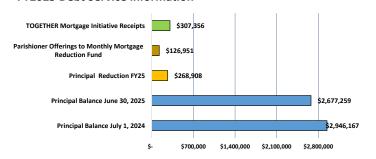
Designated Outreatch Specific Funds-receipt and disbursement occur at different intervals throughout the year.

- St. Michael was able to accomplish a great deal this past year thanks to parishioner generosity. Here are just a few things:
- Capital Expenditure needs of \$171K were met.
- The mortgage was paid down \$269K to a balance of \$2.7 million. The TOGETHER Initiative was launched to make an even bigger dent in the mortgage obligation.
- Outreach included sending a total of \$453K to Haiti, ATM, Guardian Angel and Annual Diocesan Collections.
- Columbarium had surplus operations of \$77K
- Scrip had a surplus of \$15K.
