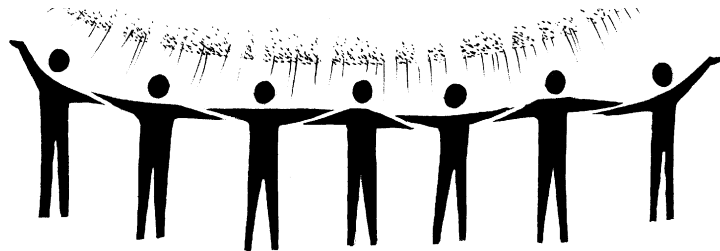
HOMILY
