

This past Easter we helped 35 families consisting of 113 moms, dads, kids and grandparents with gift cards to purchase food to celebrate the Risen Lord's Day. We can only do these things because of your generosity. 100% of the funds we receive are used to help those in our parish. We do not give out money. We pay bills. To reach us, call the rectory and ask to speak to someone from Manna, leave your first name and phone number and we will get back to you. All information is kept confidential.
