FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE



Pentecost Sunday: All four scripture readings this Sunday give us a special focus and piece of the third person of the Trinity, the Holy Spirit. Our Sequence, is a special poetic hymn, unfolding the multiple mysteries of the Holy Spirit in our lives. From the descent of the Holy Spirit on the first disciples, to the psalmist reminding us that the Spirit renews our earth and all within, to the Spirit guiding the Body of Christ and our many gifts and Christ wishing us the peace of the Holy Spirit, we have many things to

ponder! May I suggest that as we return to Ordinary Time this week, after the new memorial tomorrow, that we take a theme of the Holy Spirit each day as part of our prayers?

I also have a special prayer that I tweeted last Sunday that I pray is our prayer for June:

Holy Spirit Come! Heal & strengthen our world. Protect those on the frontline of caring for us - from the farmers in the field, to those who work in our stores, to those in the restaurants and delivery services, all the way to the healthcare facilities and everything in between. Keep us strong – together!

Memorial of Mary, Mother of the Church: Two years ago, Pope Francis added this day to the church liturgical calendar as a way to keep the spirit of Pentecost alive and remind ourselves that Mary protects our church. We will have special prayers and scripture for this day that I invite you to participate in. Each Monday after Pentecost is this special holy day. This year, especially since the pope's special liturgical service, he has been asking the care of Our Lady Help of Christians to guide and assist us during this pandemic. We pray that Mary will intercede for us again to heal our world.

About the Cover: Since last August, we really enjoyed and appreciated the work of Tony Ward, giving us a weekly cover to blend with the readings and themes of the liturgical season. We are grateful for Tony's ministry here at SPB for his 2 ½ year tenure. It is unfortunate that we are not able to keep him employed on our Pastoral Staff (with three others) due to our financial reality. I know you join with me in asking God to bless, keep safe and healthy all four and their families, of those who are not able to return, that they find meaningful employment quickly.

Meanwhile, we welcome back our parishioner and volunteer Jamie Wilhelm, '90, who created our bulletin covers for 10 years and the signs that we see around the campus. We thank you, Jamie for returning to assist us and his design work. As in the past, the photos are ones that I take on my trips, are beautiful walks around our church, capturing our architectural marvel. Today's cover photo is from visiting Saint Ann De Beaupre, Quebec. This is the international shrine for Saint Ann. I was walking around a corner of the sacristy, and lo and behold, here was a very intimate statue of Ann teaching her daughter Mary. This cover will remind us about our upcoming **Saint Ann Triduum**. We hope that Blessed Sacrament Fr Tony Schueller will be able to be present for this event. In the “Save the Date” section, we will list the events.

Videotaping will continue! Thanks to our life-time parishioner Evamarie will continue to videotape the Mass for us at 4:30 p.m. Saturday. It will be on Facebook LIVE, and then uploaded to the website like usual so that those who are unable to come will still be able to participate through viewing. Thanks, Evamarie!

Morning Prayer on Saturdays & Sundays at 8:00 a.m.: Join the Blessed Sacrament Community (associates and consecrated members) who pray that "prayer of the church," from 8:00 a.m. – 8:20 a.m. each day. Sunday Morning Prayer begins on June 14 now that we will be used to the new 8:30 a.m. start time.

Sharing Your Good News & Prayers: During the videotaped Masses I added a new feature: Good News at Paschal's! (Remember the TV jingle?) So, please call or email to share Good News! A birth, an important milestone (birthday or other), a cure, an anniversary or something that we can share to lift our spirits.

Praying Together for Our Intentions: The feedback we received while we were doing it for Lent, where we announced from our pew those we were praying for during the Mass, the sick, the deceased and our other intentions, will continue when we return. The cantor will pause, and then we may speak aloud our names that are on our hearts so that together we may pray for your special folks.

Sharing Shawls: Kay Vincent, leader of our Prayer Shawl Ministry and the lovely ladies who make them, will be offering them the First (JUNE 4) and Third Thursdays (JUNE 18) of the month from 4:30 p.m. - 6:30 p.m. at the parish office front door – Drive thru in the Horseshoe Drive on Wilson Mills Road. THEY ARE FREE! And if you want one at any other time, please do not hesitate to ask. Shawls are for anyone who would like them for themselves, family, or friends. They are meant to wrap us in prayer and care for they are blessed and prayed into existence by our lovely team of knitters. For the Thursday night pickups, all would be done according to current physical distancing, gloves, and masks. Kay says, "I would bring the shawls out into the waiting area so that no one has to go farther into the building."
