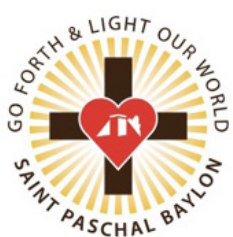

FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE...



20th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME:

What is "great faith?" Jesus tells the Canaanite woman in today's Gospel that this is the type of faith she has. This passage reminds us that first, you can question Jesus, and that questioning, lamenting and challenge leads to a deeper relationship. Second, one has great faith when they seek

out a deeper solution. The first reading from the prophet Isaiah also reminds us that when one does what is right, just and joins themselves to God, one has great faith. It's hard for me to imagine that cultural and racial barriers or boundaries would make one group of people feel that another group of people do not have "great faith." This is an underlying tension in the scriptures that Jesus and the prophets are always assisting us in dealing with our own racial prejudices. Seeing our own need for feeling from our blindness may lead us to "greater faith." Matthew is raising this point in today's Gospel for our challenge of the week.

HAPPY 90th BIRTHDAY FR ROGER: I've known Fr. Roger since I was an instrumentalist and student here at SPB. It's hard to believe that these many years have gone by for both of us, but especially for his 90th. He's proof that good living (exercise, diet, spiritual and other parts of maintaining a good life) help one lead to a wonderful age. We are grateful for his longevity and steadfastness, and his longtime presence here at SPB. We can't thank him enough for the countless hours of pastoral ministry he has shared to us. - **COMMUNION TO THE HOMEBOUND:** Family members, with a pyx, blue ritual book and missalette, share Holy Communion to each other from the Mass they attend. Retrieve Holy Communion in the Communion procession/line, sharing how many hosts you are taking home by indicating the number of hosts you need to the Communion Minister. The minister will place hosts in your pyx. Then you will place in your purse or pocket the pyx before taking the host in your own hand. Once nursing homes in the area are able to receive visitors, this ministry will start again. Sadly, it is not possible yet.
- **COMMUNION RECEPTION NEEDS:** If you are gluten intolerant, please come to the sacristy before Mass to alert the sacristan or the priest who will place a chalice for you or a low-gluten host.
- **HEARING DEVICES:** If you are hearing impaired, we have listening devices at the piano to assist you.

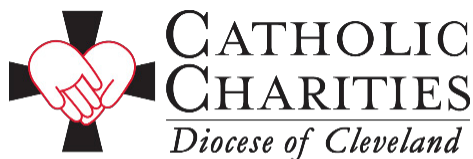



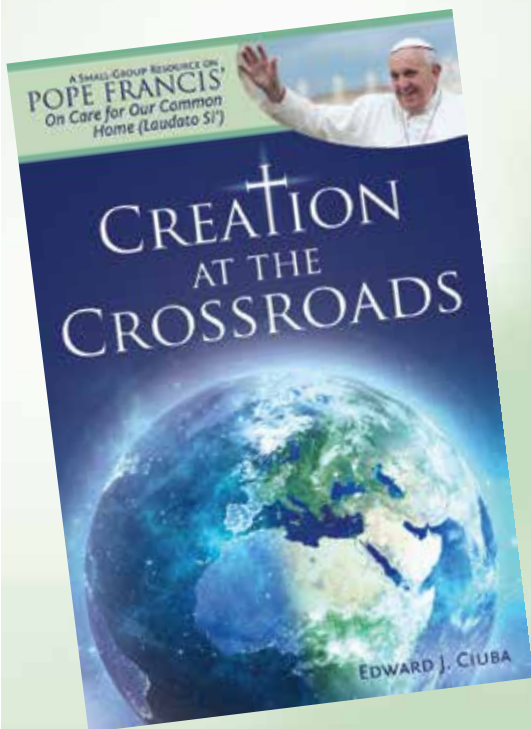
NICENE CREED
