FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE...



32nd SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: As we move closer to the end of the liturgical calendar year, our Sunday Scriptures always move us to thinking about the “end of time,” or in church speak: eschatology. Say that word a few times fast! It’s not necessary the most interesting or welcoming topic. Folks do find talking about death and the end of our lives challenging. But we are called to regularly focus on the end of our life here on earth and the life to come. Today’s readings implore us to be ready, prepared and organized. Again, this is a challenge for the procrastinators among us. A pastoral reality for all of us is making sure we are ready to meet our maker. In theological terms, we are! At our baptism, we die to ourselves, become a child of God, and are called to a discipleship that makes us ready to serve and be ready to meet Christ. During this November time, let us take the time to help those around us know of our funeral decisions, have a will finalized, submit our funeral liturgy plan to the parish, and continue to serve one another, demonstrating that we have our light lamps ready to meet the LORD.

NOVEMBER ITEMS ONLINE: George Peko and I am so grateful to hear all the compliments about our YouTube channel and the videos that we place there for your prayer and spiritual enrichment. More recently, we added the new music setting for the *Mass of Spirit and Grace* by Paulist Father Ricky Manalo. Thanks for singing along with me on the video to quickly learn the music. This musical setting was chosen for Pope Francis' Eucharistic celebration in the Sheikh Zayed Stadium in Abu Dhabi on February 5, 2019. This event was the largest gathering of Christians in the history of the Arab Peninsula (160,000+ worshippers, including 4,000 Muslims), and it was the first time a Roman Catholic Mass was ever celebrated “in public” in this region. Roberta and I are pleased you are picking it up quickly and the feedback we are hearing is that you are finding it easy to participate. During Advent and Christmas Time, the higher festival times of our liturgical calendar, we will also sing the Eucharistic Prayer.
