FROM THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE..



Word of God Sunday – 3rd SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME:

The photo to the left of this column is a picture of our altar cloth, designed by Tony Ward for this special new liturgical day. Pope Francis published *Aperuit illis*,

September 30, 2019 (Memorial of Saint Jerome, translator of the Bible), and established that "the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time [each year] be a celebration, study, and dissemination of the Word of God." The title of the pope's *motu proprio* (Latin for "of his own initiative") comes from the Gospel of Luke when the Risen Christ appeared to the disciples and "opened their minds to understand the Scriptures." The official logo is below our altar cloth, from the Pontifical Council for Promoting New Evangelization. The colorful log depicts the Road to Emmaus and is based on an icon by the late Benedictine Sister Marie-Paul Farran.

Our images help us reflect on the importance of God's Word in our life. There are still people who misbelieve that Catholic Christians do not have anything to do with the Bible. Instead, as we know, our Liturgy of the Word of the Mass is devoted to at least



twenty minutes of hearing and reflecting on God's Word, with the Hebrew Scriptures (first reading and psalm), New Testament (second reading, Gospel Acclamation, and Gospel) being primary to our celebrations. And then we walk, like the disciples to Emmaus, to reflect on God's Word with the homily. We journey with God's Word and are called to take these seeds of Scripture and nourish our faith, hope, and love, putting God's Word into practice. We journey onward with God's Word and enjoy this special Sunday once a year now to take time to appreciate "the Word made flesh and dwelling among us."

CHALICE FOR MASS: I wanted to remind you of several procedures we do for Mass, especially for those who are gluten intolerant. We do offer for anyone an individual chalice with the Precious Blood. I am one of the people worried that this command of Christ will be dropped: As a Blessed Sacrament parish devoted to the Eucharist, we do not want to lose this

vital part of our faith, sharing in the Blood of Christ, the blood of the covenant. Please come to the sacristy to get on the list to receive the Precious Blood. Those who do, come to a Communion Minister who shares your very own chalice. I also remind you that we have low-gluten hosts for those who have celiac. Also, let us know in the sacristy before Mass, and we will share this special host with you during the Communion Rite. Unfortunately, there is no such availability for a "no gluten" host. There must be a little bit of wheat/gluten in a host for the "matter" of the Eucharist.

ASSISTING IN LEADING THE PARISH: At this time of the year, I start looking to have new members for our Pastoral Council and Finance Council. We rotate members with three or six years of service to the parish. We are looking for folks who like to dream, plan, and execute projects. Take a look at the 2020 Pastoral Plan, and you will see what has been dreamt up for the next 4 years. The Finance Council implements the financial realities of the dreams with our stewardship and resources to provide for our annual budgets, review our fundraising, develop policies from audits, and much more. I like diverse representation from the parish, from young to older members of the parish. We need some women for the Finance Council and an attorney for our legal matters and advice. Thank you for asking me for more information and discerning these essential roles to guide the parish and its future. I can share the guidelines or be part of a meeting to see how things operate.

LITURGY AND SCHOOL ADVISORY: Besides the councils mentioned above of the parish, canonical bodies that every parish must have, we have two other advisory groups that plan and do many important things for the parish's life: Liturgy Commission and School Advisory Council. Every aspect of the liturgies and the school's life (with our Principal Raguz) is planned and executed for the benefit of our worship and award-winning school. Also, discern for these groups to serve our needs and support of the parish's life. For discernment on these groups, the chair of the Liturgy Commission is Vera (JJVThornton@gmail.com), or co-chairs for School Advisory are Kelly Kunchik (kkunchik@gmail.com) or Nicole Waggle (nicole.waggle10@gmail.com).

LOOKING AHEAD TO FEBRUARY 2/3: Each year, we bless candles on the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, this year on Tuesday, February 2 at the 9:00 a.m. Mass. We will begin Mass at the baptismal font, but with only the priest and altar server rather than everyone's usual gathering. Before Mass, leave your bags of candles around the font or in your place where you sit. I'll process and use holy water to bless you and your candles. Furthermore, these blessed candles are usually used on the feast of Saint Blaise to bless the throats. Instead, we will have the regular prayer prayed over the entire congregation due to COVID restrictions.

FRATELLI TUTTI TALK: Another essential document that Pope Francis wrote last year is his encyclical letter *Fratelli Tutti*, or in English, *On Fraternity and Social Friendship*. As usual, the document gets its title from the first words of the sentence of the letter. <u>Tuesday, February 2, at 6:30 p.m., will be LIVE in church and broadcast on our YouTube Channel</u>. I will give us a reflection to know more about this exceptional message of love, community, and peace.

PARISH MISSION: We will also have a special parish mission, with our spiritual director, Sr. Dianne Bergant, CSA, Zooming in from Chicago to be present with us. I'll be reading her homily for the weekend Masses, February 27/28. Then we will watch the other nights thru ZOOM, 7:00 p.m. on Monday-Wednesday, March 1-3. The Zoom link will be posted on the Saint Paschal Baylon homepage: www.church.saintpaschal.com. Thanks for planning and sharing these links with others to join us in focusing "On Our Common Home." Lent begins on Ash Wednesday! Yes, we are preparing, and thanks for creating the time to hear God's call in your life and say, "Here I am, Lord, I come to do your will." Thanks for all you do for SPB and your constant support. Let's continue to pray for each other!




