OUR REV. MICHAEL ARKINS, SSS, SENIOR PAROCHIAL VICAR

FOURTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME:

In last weekend’s Gospel passage, we heard Jesus quote a passage from Isaiah and use it as a statement of His mission - “*The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord.*” This quote invited us to reflect on Christ’s Mission as our mission.

This weekend our first reading from Jeremiah reminds us that like him we have been called by God from our mothers’ wombs to be His “prophets” as Christ’s disciples. Jesus acknowledges that He is a “prophet,” “God’s

spokesperson” in His world. As His disciples, we have been called through our Baptisms to be God’s “spokespersons” in our world. In our second reading, we heard Paul trying to help the community of Corinth realize the importance of “love” in their mission as disciples. In the list of virtues, he used to describe “love,” he told them and us how to grow in our love of God and neighbor – by being just, kind, patient, forgiving.

Through our Baptisms, we have each been called to live “love” in our particular lives. Each one of us will do this in differing ways, depending on our individual personalities, and the unique gifts the Spirit has given us. Each weekend, our bulletin has much information on what is happening in our parish and diocese. As we read it this weekend, will we be reading it just for the information, or are we open to hearing God calling us to “love,” by being just, kind, patient, forgiving?

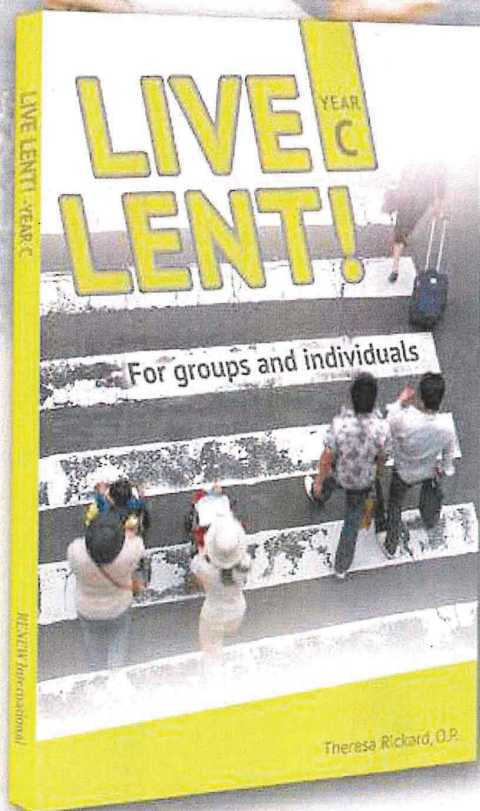
OUR 2022 SPRING FLING CORNER
