ASCENSION OF OUR LORD: We are almost complete with the Easter Season celebrating the Ascension of our Lord. There are multiple accounts of the Ascension in the Gospels. Today's starts out as a news report, reminding us why there are two volumes to Luke's writing. It is so interesting that Luke wraps up his Gospel and the Ascension one way, with a blessing, and the disciples are filled with joy, wanting to worship. Then the Acts version has the disciples bringing a particular question before the ascension.

Furthermore, the mission is promoted by the "angels," two men dressed in white saying not just to hang around looking at the sky: get busy! Do what Christ commanded us to do! This sets off the mission that will come to a dramatic, spiritfilled turn of events that we will conclude with next week's reading. But for this day, we remember how important it is that we live the mission of Christ and do not "sky gaze." What is God calling me to do next to serve?






