OUR PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE...

THE MOST HOLY TRINITY: Each year, we are given this solemnity to contemplate the gift of our God in the form of the Most Holy Trinity. Today's readings give us insight into a God who finds delight in the human race (First Reading), justifies us by faith (Second Reading) and helps us along the way to give us the truth when we are ready for it (Gospel). God walks with us in our journey of faith and does not give us more than we can handle. Jesus' final discourse and prayer with His disciples at the Last Supper is a great awakening for us to remember that all good things come in time and when we are ready. Hopefully, we grow in trust each day with our prayer. When we sign ourselves with the Cross or the Trinity at the beginning of each day, we recall the sign placed on us at our Baptism; we recommit to true discipleship for our God who does wonderful things for us. For that, we give praise and come to **Eucharist each Sunday!**



TODAY'S PHOTO & NEXT WEEKEND: This bulletin column is compiled on May 31 due to the holidays and vacation schedules of our Pastoral Staff and bulletin printer. Next Sunday, we celebrate a very important solemnity in the life of the church but also in our own parish, dedicated to being a Eucharistic community. The photo shows last year's procession with the Blessed Sacrament. We have been blessed to do this around the block when the weather is wonderful. We have been blessed with 13 great years in a row – and we pray for that to continue this year. New this year, due to the fact that

the US Church is beginning the Eucharistic Revival Years, there will be a procession <u>in the church</u> at the 4:30 PM, 8:30 AM & 6:30 PM weekend Masses, too. The only outdoor one (weather permitting), will be at the 10:30 AM Mass. This "big one" outside has our ministry leaders and this year's First Communicants in the procession. You can see one of our students in this procession, and we hope as many as possible of our families are able to be present to keep the tradition of the church, from the 13th century, of procession with the Risen Christ.

NEW COMMUNION MINISTERS FOR CHURCH & HOMEBOUND MINISTRY: As we focus on the Eucharist this month, let us recall that we have many who are homebound who really appreciate receiving Holy Communion for our parish and our Masses. So many still participate in our Eucharist by watching our YouTube Channel. This is allowed for those not able to attend Mass in person and then a minister from our church, after retrieving a host and blessing after Communion, leaves our sanctuary to go immediately to the house and pray with one of our parishioners. If you would like to assist in distribution of Holy Communion in the church during Mass, please contact George Zagar at <u>zagarga@gmail.com</u> or come to the sacristy before Mass to have "on the job" training from our excellent sacristans and ministers. To further supplement your training here, the diocese is now offering a class again with a special certification. The parish is happy to pay for your tuition to receive the faith formation to deepen your ministry and discipleship. Contact George for more details.

NEW THEME FOR NEXT YEAR: Each year, our Pastoral Staff develops a theme for us to live and focus on our Eucharistic parish mission. For the church's 50th anniversary we had the theme, "Go forth and light our world." For July 2022-June 2023, we have chosen, under the inspiration of George Peko, "LISTEN – LITURGY – LOVE." As we prepare for our 70th year as a parish family, we have to listen to God and one another to discern the will of the Holy Spirit in our parish's life. We listen to God to be His true witness and live our vocation of discipleship in the world. Where do we wish to go with God's guidance? We celebrate that God has blessed us by LITURGY, and we purposely take an active role in

having folks return to CELEBRATE and LIVE the Mass. Being the Body of Christ is like a sports team: we need each other as a "people of faith." That calls us to LOVE. For God's love has touched us in the Eucharistic liturgy and then calls us to serve, to be the Eucharist to others in the world; in short: TO LOVE! The theme song that we will use during this time is "Open Our Eyes." Let us all together LISTEN, come to the LITURGY, and then serve in LOVE in our world that needs to "open our eyes" to God's love and many gifts.

ONGOING MAINTENANCE: When we worked on the capital campaign for the new driveways and parking lots, we committed to doing the biannual maintenance that a new asphalt surface needs to maintain its strength and long-term use. Our commitment remains firm as we prepare for Monday-Friday, June 13-17, when we will be sealing, filling cracks, and striping the south church parking lots. The East Side parking lot will be first, on Monday, June 13, and then move to the other side once complete. Pray for great weather. Thanks for your generous donations to the maintenance fund for this and the funds from our capital campaign that always keep improving our campus. Thanks for your patience during weekday Masses as you adjust where you park.



DEACON DAVID SEES THE POWER OF SPIRITUAL HOME IMPROVEMENTS

It's harder to let your Christian light shine if you're short on outlets.

Fortunately, the *Heart of a Shepherd* campaign is funding much-needed interior renovations to Borromeo Seminary and Saint Mary Seminary and Graduate School of Theology - providing at least one unexpected spiritual benefit to future priests like Deacon David Chojnacki.

"My room now accommodates a chair and lamp. Outlets were few and far between before these renovations." While this may sound like a minor convenience, David, 26, says the improvements have impacted his faith. "It's so nice to have these beautiful spaces that naturally lend themselves to prayer and reflection."

In April, David was ordained a transitional deacon and is excited to begin his assignment at St. Mary Parish in Painesville this summer. And while the renovations are only about halfway complete, Deacon Chojnacki tells us they've brought new energy (beyond the electrical outlets) to the campus.




